**God's initiative! My response?**

*Yes, God so loved the world (you and me), that He gave his only Son (Jn.3:16). Whoever loves me will keep my word, and my Father will love him and we will come to him and make our dwelling with him (Jn.14:23). The mystery... hidden from ages and generations past... is Christ in you! (Col.1:26-27). Brothers and sisters, our most personal response to God's initiative of love needs to be an intentional, sufficient, daily, regular life style of prayer and service. Our life-style should include prayer of the heart, Holy Mass, spiritual reading, study of God's Word in Scripture and Catechism, examination of conscience, confession, fasting, works of mercy, and sharing our faith. Regular devotions like a daily rosary, chaplet of mercy and Eucharistic adoration are encouraged. "Examine yourselves to see whether you are living in faith. Test yourselves! Do you not realize that Jesus Christ is in you? – unless, of course, you fail the test (2Cor.13:5). To encourage you not to fail the test, I recommend an encouraging book on prayer life from our Marelo Book Store, Hidden Mountain, Secret Garden, by Anthony Lilles.*
