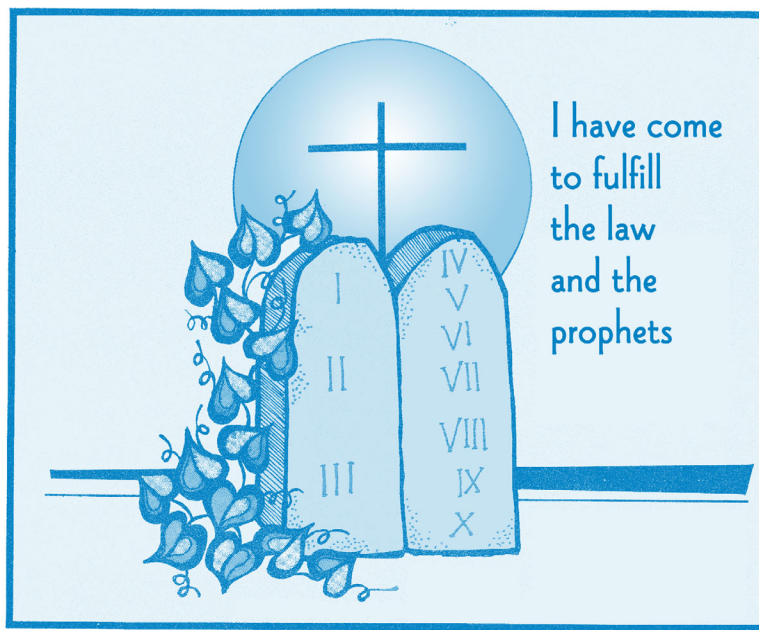

PASTOR'S CORNER

The TOB Time Bomb

In his biography of Pope John Paul II, Witness to Hope, George Weigel, predicted that Blessed John Paul's most valuable and lasting contribution to the Church would be his teaching called "the Theology of the Body," or, TOB for short. In a world where many Catholics in the secular West dissent from the Church's teaching against elective abortion, contraception, sterilization and sins against the virtue of chastity, whether hetero or homo sexual in nature, the Pope's Theology of the Body, will be like a time bomb going off sometime in the twenty-first century. Thankfully, this time bomb is already exploding in St. Joachim Parish as evidenced by our marriage preparation programs and our TOB youth retreats in both Spanish and English.

I was sitting in on a TOB board meeting on Monday when I heard this testimony from one of the youth leaders. "Instead of dwelling on rules that tell me what I ought not to do, TOB has opened my eyes to what I can do. The truth about my dignity as a human being and the God-given meaning of my body/mind/heart/spirit/sexuality has liberated me to live an abundant life in community, in love and in Christ."

Let us pray for those who are sharing the treasure of TOB and for those who are receiving it in our marriage prep and NFP classes and retreats, and in our TOB bilingual youth group and retreats.
