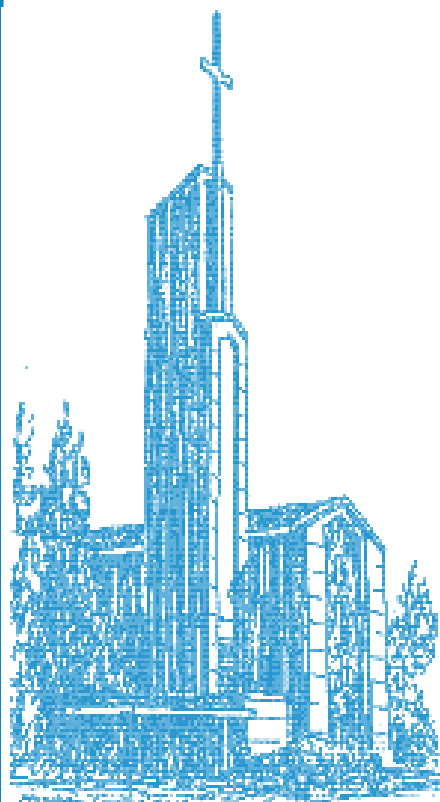

PASTOR'S CORNER

Intensify your Prayer Life this Lent! Last week we heard from St. Peter Chrysologus, "Prayer, Mercy and Fasting: if you have only one of them, or not all together, you have nothing." Granting this, let us now focus on the meaning and importance of Christian prayer in this inseparable trio. Hear the wisdom of St. John Chrysostom. "Prayer and converse with God is a supreme good: it is a partnership and union with God... I do not mean the prayer of outward observance but prayer from the heart, not confined to fixed times or periods but continuous throughout the day and night... It is the longing for God, love too deep for words, a gift not given by man but by God's grace. The Apostle Paul says, 'We do not know how we are to pray but the Spirit himself pleads for us with inexpressible longings' (Rom. 8:26). Constant prayer in our hearts, which is a sheer gift and initiative of God, invites a free and personal response from each of us. Our response will determine whether our prayer life, that is, our personal relationship with God, is anemic or robust. Our response will enter the realm of outward observance. Am I cultivating the basic discipline of **daily, sufficient, quiet, personal prayer time**? It helps to have a determined **time, place and passage of Scripture** to launch me into my time of conscious **prayer of the heart** each day. If I live with others, such as a spouse and children, it helps to have an agreement with them so that all may work to protect each one's special quiet prayer time from distraction and unnecessary interruption. Have I scheduled this essential time of quiet personal prayer into my life-style? **This Lent, Intensify your Prayer Life!**

Asentado esto, centrémonos ahora en el significado y la importancia de la oración Cristiana de este trío inseparable. Escucha la sabiduría de San Juan Crisóstomo. "Orar y conversar con Dios es un bien supremo: es una asociación y unión con Dios... No me refiero a la oración de respeto exterior sino a la oración que viene del corazón, no se limita a horas fijas o periodos sino que continua durante todo el día y la noche... Es el anhelo de Dios, el amor más profundo que las palabras, es un don que no se da por el hombre sino por la gracia de Dios. El Apóstol Pablo dice, 'Porque no sabemos orar como es, pero el Espíritu ruega a Dios por nosotros con gemidos que no pueden expresarse con palabras' (Rom. 8:26). La oración constante en nuestros corazones, es un verdadero regalo e iniciativa de Dios, invita a una respuesta personal de cada uno de nosotros. Nuestra respuesta determinará si nuestra oración de vida, es decir, nuestra relación personal con Dios, es anémica o saludable.
