**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**THE MEANING OF THE MASS. Liturgy of the WORD (cont.) "What does it mean to say, 'God Speaks'?"** ... Creation itself is God speaking. Creation is His expression, and He has placed us within it with a capacity to discern His Word there and respond to it. We are not meant to listen to some loud voice booming down from the sky, but to the creation itself and to our own selves as part of it. ...The sin of our first parents was a failure to discern this Word whose origins are in God. ... 'The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us' (John 1:14). This means that God is expressing Himself no longer merely in the creation but also *within* the very unfolding of human history. ...The Word of God is not a book, is not the Bible as a bunch of words whose meaning we are meant to figure out. The Word of God is the creation, is the history of Israel, is the story of Jesus Christ. ...Indeed, the joy of hearing the story of creation and of Israel's history is to see its culmination in Christ. Every detail is garnered and pondered for what it can reveal of Him" (from What Happens at Mass by Jeremy Driscoll, OSB). More to come.

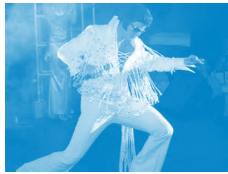

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**EL SIGNIFICADO DE LA MISA. Liturgia de la PALABRA (cont.) “¿Qué significa decir ‘Dios habla’? ...** La Creación misma es Dios hablando. La Creación es Su expresión, y Él nos ha colocado dentro de ella con una capacidad para discernir su Palabra y responder a ella. No estamos destinados a escuchar una voz fuerte resonante que viene desde el cielo, sino a la creación misma y a nosotros mismos como parte de ello. El pecado de nuestros primeros padres fue un fracaso para discernir esta Palabra cuyos orígenes provienen de Dios. ...’Y la palabra se hizo carne y habitó entre nosotros’ (Juan 1:14). Esto significa que Dios se expresa no solamente en la creación *sino* también en el seno de la propia evolución de la historia de la humanidad. ...La Palabra de Dios no es un libro, no es la Biblia como un montón de palabras cuyo significado se supone que debemos de averiguar. La Palabra de Dios es la creación, es la historia de Israel, es la historia de Jesucristo. ...De hecho, la alegría de escuchar la historia de la creación y la historia de Israel es ver su culminación en Cristo.
