PASTOR'S CORNER

A Practical Way to Receive THE GIFT. Last week we spoke about how receiving God's GIFT OF SELF is at the heart of God's Will for us and the purpose of the ongoing Passion, Easter and Pentecost mysteries in the life of the Church. God's initiative and our response becomes personal in the mystery of prayer; prayer in the life of each disciple, and in the shared life of the Church. Thus, one of the best practical ways to receive THE GIFT is to **PRAY the LORD'S PRAYER** in the Spirit with understanding and love. "When you pray, say, 'Our Father' ... (Mt. 6:9). The Catechism of the Catholic Church says the Lord's Prayer "is truly the summary of the whole gospel" (CCC 2761). St. Thomas Aquinas taught, "*The Lord's Prayer is the most perfect of prayers ... In it we ask, not only for the things we can rightly desire, but also in the sequence that they should be desired. This prayer not only teaches us how to ask for things, but also in what order we should desire them (CCC 2763).*" St. Augustine concludes, "*Run through all the words of the holy prayers [in Scripture], and I do not think you will find anything in them that is not contained and included in the Lord's Prayer*" (CCC. 2762). In other words, The Lord's Prayer contains everything we really need and it's guaranteed! **It contains THE GIFT!** (More on the Lord's Prayer next week.)
