PASTOR'S CORNER

Love Is Our Mission: The Family Fully Alive Part 5: Creating the Future. "Marriage is meant to be fertile and to welcome new life. (...) Without children there can be no future. (...) 'These children are links in a chain, said Pope Francis. You parents have a baby son or daughter to be baptized, but in several years, it will be they that have a baby to baptize, or a grandchild; and so, the chain of faith.' Sexual intimacy between men and women raises the possibility of children. No other relationship carries this basic, organic, biological possibility. Marriage between a man and a woman brings this potential fertility into a spiritual context. Parenting is a spiritual vocation, for it ultimately means preparing our children to be saints. This bold ambition entails humble but important practices in the home, such as prayer and cultivating a spiritual disposition. (...) The world today is often alien and even hostile to faith. In a fragmented culture, where the social and media environment may undermine parental authority in general and Catholic parenting in particular, parents and children need to reflect on their family's way of being in the world without belonging to the world. (...) Parenting is demanding. (...) Parenting has a way of deflating pretenses; of making us see that we are not self sufficient but need help and strength from God, family, parish and friends. (...) 'Divine love' is not something to be reserved for important matters, but must be pursued chiefly in the ordinary circumstances of life. Parents can discover what Saint Paul meant when he said, 'whenever I am weak, then I am strong.' (2Cor 12:10) (...) For a parish to actually be a 'family of families,' calls for concrete actions of hospitality and generosity. (...) There is no substitute for ordinary parishioners simply befriending and serving one another during the week, extending church beyond Sunday mornings. **Love Is Our Mission** is available at the St. Marelllo Bookstore. RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

El Amor Es Nuestra Misión - La Familia Plenamente Viva. Parte 5: Crear el Futuro. “El matrimonio tiene como propósito ser fértil y recibir la vida nueva. (...) Sin niños no puede haber futuro. (...) “Estos niños son el eslabón de una cadena, dijo el Papa Francisco. Vosotros padres traéis a bautizar al niño o a la niña, pero en algunos años serán ellos los que traerán a bautizar a un niño, o a un nietecito; así es la cadena de la fe.’ La intimidad sexual entre un hombre y una mujer genera la posibilidad de engendrar hijos. Ninguna otra relación brinda esta posibilidad básica, orgánica y biológica. El matrimonio entre un hombre y una mujer brinda esta fertilidad potencial en un contexto espiritual. Ser padres es una vocación espiritual, porque, en definitiva, significa preparar a nuestros hijos para que sean santos. Esta valiente ambición requiere humildes pero importantes prácticas en el hogar, como rezar y cultivar una disposición espiritual. (...) El mundo de hoy es frecuentemente extraño e incluso hostil a la fe. En una cultura fragmentada, donde el ambiente de los medios sociales y de comunicación pueden socavar en general la autoridad de los padres y la crianza católica en particular, los padres y los hijos necesitan reflexionar sobre la manera en que la familia está en el mundo sin pertenecer a este. (...) La paternidad es demandante. (...) ‘La Caridad Divina’ no hay que buscarla únicamente en los acontecimientos importantes, sino ante todo en la vida ordinaria. Los padres pueden descubrir lo que San Pablo quería decir con “Pues si me siento débil, entonces es cuando soy fuerte.” (2Cor 12:10) Para que una parroquia sea realmente una ‘familia de familias,’ debe realizar acciones concretas de hospitalidad y generosidad. (...) No hay sustituto para los feligreses comunes que, simplemente, se brindan mutua amistad y servicio durante la semana, extendiendo la Iglesia más allá de las mañanas dominicales. **El Amor Es Nuestra Misión** está disponible en la Librería San Marelló.
