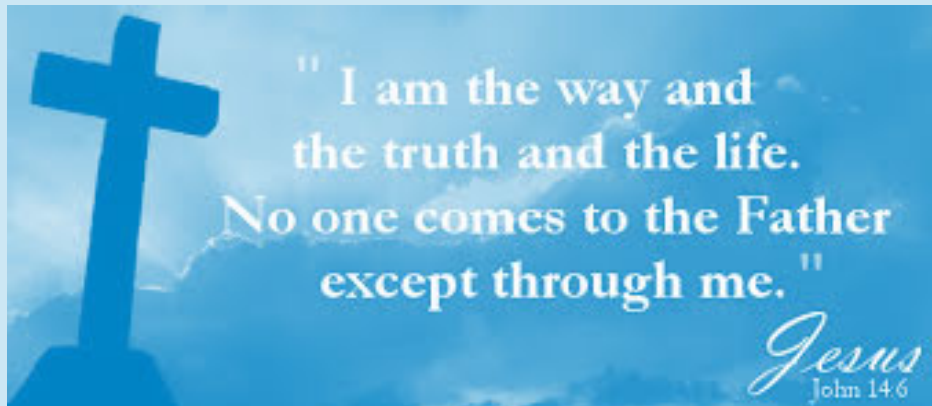

PASTOR'S CORNER

"The un-examined life is not worth living" (Socrates). "Examine yourselves, to see whether you are holding to your faith. Test yourselves. Do you not realize that Jesus Christ is in you? – Unless indeed you fail to meet the test! (St. Paul – 2Cor.13:5). Back by popular demand, - how to do a good daily examination of conscience, – taken from the endnotes of 33 Days to Morning Glory. It is as simple as remembering the acronym, **B-A-K-E-R**.

B – Count your Blessings from the last 24 hours and give thanks to God.

A – Ask the Holy Spirit to show you where you are missing the mark, that is, where you are sinning.

K – Kill, those weaknesses, attachments and sins with sincere sorrow, repentance and reparation.

E – Allow Jesus to Embrace you with the rays of his merciful love.

R – Take what you learned from the previous points and make Resolutions to do good or repair wrongdoing in practical ways. For instance, I resolve to give some quality time to this exam daily, either before I go to bed, or, during my morning quiet time in prayer.

I - Significa "invocar". Aquí necesitamos invocar al Espíritu Santo y pedirle la gracia especial de reconocer nuestra naturaleza pecaminosa.

R - Significa "reparar". Matar, esas debilidades, apegos y pecados con una gran pena sincera, arrepentimiento y reparación.

A - Significa "abrazar". Es permitir que Jesus nos abrace, con los rayos de su amor misericordioso.

R - Significa "resolverse". Tomar lo que has aprendido de los pasos anteriores y hacer resoluciones para hacer el bien o para reparar irregularidades de una manera práctica. Por ejemplo, resuelvo dar tiempo de calidad a este examen todos los días, ya sea antes de que me vaya a la cama, o durante mi tiempo tranquilo en la mañana en mi oración.
