**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Am I happy?** A 92-year-old, petite, well poised and proud man, who is fully dressed each morning by eight o' clock, with his hair combed and shaved perfectly, even though he is legally blind, moved to a nursing home today. His wife of 70 years recently passed away, making the move necessary. After many hours of waiting patiently in the lobby of the nursing home, he smiled sweetly when told his room was ready. As he maneuvered his walker to the elevator, I provided a visual description of his tiny room, including the eyelet sheets that had been hung on his window. "I love it," he stated with the enthusiasm of an eight-year-old having just been presented with a new puppy. "Mr. Jones, you haven't seen the room; just wait." "That doesn't have anything to do with it," he replied. Happiness is something you decide on ahead of time. Whether I like my room or not doesn't depend on how the furniture is arranged ... it's how I arrange my mind. I already decided to love it. It's a decision I make every morning when I wake up. I have a choice; I can spend the day in bed recounting the difficulty I have with the parts of my body that no longer work, or get out of bed and be thankful for the ones that do." There is a kernel of wisdom here. It is similar to the proverb, "keep your eye upon the dough-nut and not upon the hole." But, we want to go beyond the clichés of the power of positive thinking, looking on the bright side and maintaining an attitude of gratitude. We want our happiness to be firmly grounded in reality, the reality of God's love for each of us in every present moment. Or, as St. Joseph Mareello put it, "We cannot doubt Jesus' love for us; so cheer up."

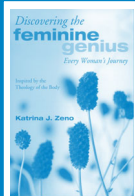


### THE HARVEST FESTIVAL

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**¿Soy feliz?** Un hombre de 92 años, menudito, bien preparado y orgulloso, completamente vestido cada mañana a las ocho, con su cabello peinado y afeitado perfectamente, a pesar de que es legalmente ciego se mudó el día de hoy a un asilo. Su esposa de 70 años falleció recientemente, por lo cual era necesario que se mudara. Después de esperar pacientemente por muchas horas en el vestíbulo del asilo, sonrió dulcemente cuando le dijeron que su habitación estaba lista. Mientras maniobraba su andador hacia el ascensor, le dí una descripción visual de su pequeño cuarto, incluyendo las cortinas de ojal que habían sido colgadas en su ventana. "Me encanta", afirmó con el entusiasmo de un niño de ocho años de edad, a quien le acaban de presentar un nuevo cachorro. "Señor Jones, aún no ha visto el cuarto; solo espere." "Eso no tiene nada que ver", respondió. "La felicidad es algo que tú decides con anticipación. Si me gusta o no mi cuarto, no depende de cómo este arreglado el mobiliario ... es como yo lo pongo en mi mente. Ya he decidido que me encanta. Es una decisión que hago cada mañana cuando me despierto. Tengo la opción de pasarme el día en la cama recordando la dificultad que tengo con las partes de mi cuerpo que ya no funcionan, o levantarme de la cama y estar agradecido por las que lo hacen." Hay un núcleo de la sabiduría. Es similar al refrán, "mantén tu ojo en la tuerca y no en el agujero." Pero, queremos ir mas allá de los tópicos del poder del pensamiento positivo, mirando el lado positivo y manteniendo una actitud de gratitud. Queremos que nuestra felicidad se base firmemente en la realidad, la realidad del amor de Dios para cada uno de nosotros en cada momento. O, como San José Marello dijo; "No podemos dudar del amor de Jesús por nosotros; así que ánimo."
