PASTOR'S CORNER

"Be merciful as your Heavenly Father is merciful" (Lk.6:36). But, how can I forgive someone who has deliberately hurt me, is not sorry, and who does not deserve to be forgiven? Let us presume that I am willing to forgive that person in order to be obedient to God, but that I don't know how. The only thing that comes natural with regard to that "enemy" is anger, bitterness and coldness. Here is how I have learned to do it. First, I use my God-given ability to transcend myself. In my imagination, I go up as high as Jesus is on the cross. Then I look down and see myself and my "enemy" from Jesus' perspective. By God's grace I see more than meets the natural eye. From Jesus' perspective I see my enemy being attacked by evil spirits. I see that evil spirits are attacking me as well. I see that I and all my fellow human beings are in the same boat and that *"our battle is not against flesh and blood but against...the spiritual hosts of wickedness in the heavenly places"* (Eph.6: 12). I hear Jesus praying from the cross, *"Father, forgive them; for they know not what they do"* (Lk.23:34). I consent to Jesus' desire to unite his heart with mine. Suddenly I am feeling compassion for my "enemy" and am motivated to pray together with Jesus for him or her. **It's a miracle of mercy! It's the triumph of good over evil! ALLELUIA!**
