PASTOR'S CORNER

IT'S WAR! Who is our enemy and what is his most dangerous weapon?

There are some enemies that cannot be defeated by a strong military and a well equipped police force. St. Paul **tells us that "our battle is not against flesh and blood, but against evil spirits" (Eph.6: 12). St. Paul also** tells us that we receive our armor and our weapons from God: truth, integrity, hope of salvation, gospel of peace, faith, the Word of God, and persevering intercessory prayer (cf. Eph.6:13-18). Pope Saint John Paul II and Pope Emeritus Benedict XVI have warned us that the greatest threat to world peace and justice in our times is RELATIVISM. In this view, factual knowledge and "truth" are presumed to be confined to the physical sciences by definition. Relativists hold that there is no objective, absolute or universal truth in the realm of religious faith and morality. For relativists, "truths" of faith and morals are relegated by definition to the realm of subjective, private, personal opinion. The ideology of relativism is another name for the state of original sin where-in the creature becomes his or her own god, deciding for one self what is good or evil without reference to divine authority. The ideology of relativism smells of sulfur and has the claw marks of our arch enemy, the father of lies, all over it. Reach for your armor and your weapons, but make sure they are the spiritual armor and weapons supplied to us by God. (To be continued.)

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

¡ES GUERRA! ¿Quién es nuestro enemigo y cuál es su arma más peligrosa?

Hay algunos enemigos que no pueden ser derrotados por un ejército y una fuerza policial bien equipada. San Pablo nos dice que "nuestra lucha no es en contra las fuerzas humanas, pero contra las fuerzas oscuras" (Efe.6:12). San Pablo también nos dice que también recibimos nuestra armadura y armas de Dios: verdad, integridad, esperanza de salvación, evangelio de paz, fe, la Palabra de Dios, y perseverante oración intercesora (cf.Eph.6:13-18). El Papa San Juan Pablo II y el Papa Emeritus Benedict XVI nos han advertido que la mayor amenaza para la paz mundial y la justicia en nuestros tiempos es el RELATIVISMO. En este punto de vista, conocimiento factual y "verdad" se supone que se limitan a las ciencias físicas por definición. Los relativistas sostienen que no existe ninguna razón objetiva, absoluta o universal en el ámbito de la fe religiosa y moral. Para los relativistas, las "verdades," de fe y morales son relegadas por definición al ámbito subjetivo, privado y de opinión personal. La idea del relativismo es otro nombre para el estado de pecado original en-donde la criatura se convierte en su propio Dios, decidiendo por uno mismo lo que es bueno o malo sin hacer referencia a la autoridad divina. La ideología del relativismo huele a azufre y tiene por todas partes las marcas de garras de nuestro enemigo, el padre de las mentiras. Agarra tu armadura y tus armas, pero asegúrate de que son las armas y armadura espiritual suministradas por Dios. (Continuará).
