PASTOR'S CORNER

Love Is Our Mission: The Family Fully Alive. Those who use Natural Family Planning unselfishly have found that it improves married life. Part of the reason for this is because there is a built-in Courtship and Honeymoon mechanism involved in NFP. Sexual relations aren't taken for granted. Couples develop non-genital ways of showing affection they wouldn't normally think about – just as they did when they were courting. **For many wives**, the fact that her husband is working with her to learn and use NFP is a sign of affection. A wife has a new respect for her husband's manliness when she sees his ability to control himself sexually out of love for her. In other words, you take your wife "for better or for worse." If God has made you a fertile couple, that is a great gift. Maybe wives appreciate this more than husbands do. They seem to be more in touch with the "baby" side of sex. Men in our culture have been happy to abdicate responsibility for birth control, and over the years this has led to considerable resentment among women. Today a husband has no legal say over a "woman's right to abortion." Would this have happened if men had cooperated with their wives by using Natural Family Planning, respecting the gift of fertility and their own privilege as co-creators with God? The thought of abstaining from sex can be daunting. It is a sacrifice, and the question may arise, "for what good?" St. Paul instructed men to love their wives "as Christ loved the Church and gave Himself up for her." (Eph. 5:25) Christ loved the Church by sacrificing Himself totally "that she might be holy and without blemish." (Eph. 5:27) (Excerpt from the flyer, "Man to Man" by the Couple to Couple League) More to come.

El Amor Es Nuestra Misión: La Familia Plenamente Viva. Aquellos que usan la Planificación Familiar Natural desinteresadamente han encontrado que mejora la vida de casados. Parte de la razón es porque hay un mecanismo de cortejo y de luna de miel integrados en el Curso de PFN. Las relaciones sexuales no se dan por asentadas. Las parejas desarrollan formas no-genitales de mostrar afecto que normalmente no pensarían - tal como lo hicieron cuando se estaban cortejando. **Para muchas mujeres**, el hecho de que su esposo esté trabajando con ella para aprender y usar la PFN es una muestra de cariño. La mujer tiene un nuevo respeto a la virilidad de su marido cuando ella ve su capacidad de controlarse sexualmente por amor a ella. En otras palabras, tomas a tu esposa "para bien o para mal." Si Dios te ha hecho una pareja fértil, es un gran regalo. Tal vez las esposas lo aprecian más que los esposos. Al parecer ellas están más en contacto con el lado "bebé" del sexo. Los hombres en nuestra cultura han sido felices en abdicar la responsabilidad de control de la natalidad, y con el paso de los años esto ha dado lugar a un considerable resentimiento entre las mujeres. Hoy en día un marido no tiene opinión jurídica sobre el "derecho de la mujer al aborto." ¿Habría sucedido esto si los hombres hubieran cooperado con sus mujeres mediante el uso de la Planificación Familiar Natural, respetando el don de la fertilidad, y su privilegio como co-creadores con Dios? La idea de abstenerse de tener relaciones sexuales puede ser desalentador. Es un sacrificio, y puede surgir la pregunta, "¿para qué sirve?" San Pablo instruyó a los hombres a amar a sus esposas "Como Cristo amo a la Iglesia y se entregó a si mismo por ella." (Ef. 5:25) Cristo amó a la iglesia al sacrificarse totalmente "una Iglesia santa e inmaculada." (Ef. 5:27) (Un extracto del folleto, "De Hombre a Hombre" por la Liga de Pareja a Pareja.)
