40 DAYS FOR LIFE! *"But I feel that the greatest destroyer of peace today is abortion, because it is a war against the child – a direct killing of the innocent child – murder by the mother herself. And if we accept that a mother can kill her own child, how can we tell other people not to kill one another? How do we persuade a woman not to have an abortion? As always, we must persuade her with love" (Blessed Mother Teresa of Calcutta).* Abortion is the leading cause of death in the world today. We can join with over 625,000 volunteers this Fall to help change that. Our parish's pro-life ministry, Esperanza de Vida, is providing leadership for all of us to act in practical ways in this critical battle to conquer evil with love: to provide healing for post abortion mothers and fathers, to provide support for women with crisis pregnancies, and to prize and welcome all children who are created by God to love and be loved. The annual international 40 DAYS FOR LIFE Campaigns, founded in 2007, can help us to intensify our efforts to value and save lives and souls. The Fall campaign runs from September 24 – November 2. It consists of 40 days of prayer and fasting, 40 days of peaceful prayer vigils, and 40 days of community outreach.
