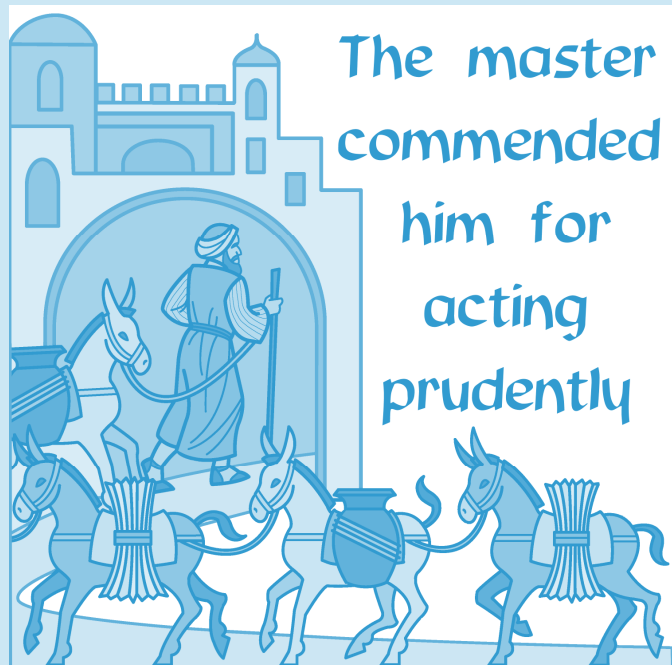

PASTOR'S CORNER

We are all "saints under construction". The construction needs to be monitored in order to avoid the use of shoddy materials or failures to meet the code of holiness. I recommend the following daily examination of conscience to keep our growth in sanctity on track and on schedule. I use the acronym BAKER:

B Blessing: Praise God and give thanks for the Blessings you can identify in your life over the last 24 hours.

A Ask: Ask the Holy Spirit to show you where you have been "missing the mark", i.e. sinning.

K Kill: crucify, put to death, renounce and repent of any sin or near occasion of sin.

E Embrace: Let yourself be Embraced by Divine Mercy.

R Resolve: Resolve to learn from mistakes and to do better in the days ahead.
