PASTOR'S CORNER

Thanksgiving and Generosity are two sides of the same coin. To whom should I give? Here are FIVE PRINCIPLES FOR GIVING taken from Fr. Michael Gaitley's book, 'You Did It to Me' A Practical Guide to Mercy in Action (highly recommended and available in the St. Marelo Book Store).

1. Keep It Close to Home – the Principle of Subsidiarity: Without neglecting pressing needs on a global level, problems in human society ought to be handled on the level closest to those who are affected.
2. Give to Those Who Have Given to You – The Principle of Gratitude: What works-of-mercy-organizations have helped me? Catholic school? Catholic Charities? Parish Ministries? Etc.?
3. Give to Those in Greatest Need – The Preferential Option for the Poor: These "least ones," referred to by Jesus in Mt. 25, should always have a preferential place in our hearts and minds.
4. Give Yourself – Almsgiving in Action: If you can give, not just your treasure, but your time and talent as well, then do it.
5. Give the Lord a Chance to Speak – the Principle of Prayer: Ask the Holy Spirit for wisdom in discerning his will for how you can best give your time, treasure and talents to those who are most in need.

Our parish soup kitchen, called the Holy Family Table, is a multifaceted work of mercy in which we can all participate with time and talent, or treasure, or, perhaps all three. Please be mindful of the collections supporting the Holy Family Table on Thanksgiving Day (7am & 10 am), and on the weekend Masses for the first Sunday of Advent, Nov. 29-30.
