**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**THE MEANING OF THE MASS – The Apostolic Greeting.**

*"May the grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, the love of God and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all."* This greeting, along with others, like, *"The Lord be with you,"* or, *"Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,"* are called, **"apostolic,"** because they are taken from those used by the apostle, Paul. "The priest greets the people not as an individual, some friendly person whom they may or may not know especially well. He greets them in his sacramental role of representing Christ at the head of his body, as Christ who will lead his body in prayer... (The priest sees the congregation) "as an assembly of baptized people who are poised for the great sacrifice and act of worship to which their Baptism has admitted them... It is the Lord himself whom we are meant to see and hear in this unusual gesture of gracious openness, spoken in unusual language from a man dressed in unusual clothes." The assembly's response of, *"And with your spirit,"* "is not meant to say something to the effect of, 'the same to you.' It means much more. The people are addressing the "spirit" of the priest; that is, that deepest interior part of his being where he has been ordained precisely to lead the people in this sacred action." ## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

### EL SIGNIFICADO DE LA MISA—El Saludo Apostólico.

*“Que la gracia de nuestro Señor Jesucristo, el amor del Padre y la comunión del Espíritu Santo esté con todos ustedes.”* Este saludo, junto con otros como, *“El Señor esté con ustedes,”* o, *“La gracia y la paz de parte de Dios, nuestro Padre y de Jesucristo, el Señor, estén con todos ustedes,”* se llaman, **“apostólicos,”** porque se toman de los usados por el apóstol, Pablo. “El sacerdote saluda a la gente no como a un individuo, sino como a una persona amistosa que puede o no puede conocer bien. Los saluda en su papel sacramental de representar a Cristo a la cabeza de su cuerpo, así como Cristo llevará su cuerpo a la oración... (El sacerdote ve a los feligreses) ” como una asamblea de personas bautizadas que están preparadas para el gran sacrificio y el acto de adoración al cual su Bautismo los ha admitido... Es el Señor mismo quien se supone que debemos ver y escuchar en este gesto amable inusual de apertura, hablando un lenguaje inusual viniendo de un hombre vestido con ropa inusual.” La respuesta de la asamblea es, *“Y con tu espíritu,”* “no se trata de decir algo al efecto de, ‘lo mismo para usted.’ Esto significa mucho más. La gente esta hablando al “espíritu” del sacerdote; es decir, esa parte interior más profunda de su ser donde ha sido ordenado precisamente para conducir a la gente a esta acción sagrada.” (Notas tomadas de What Happens At Mass, por Jeremy Driscoll, OSB.)
