PASTOR'S CORNER

Love Is Our Mission: The Family Fully Alive PART 6; LIGHT IN A DARK WORLD. When the Church was empowered by the Holy Spirit on Pentecost nearly 2,000 years ago, the dominant Greek and Roman pagan cultures were steeped in attitudes that approved of sexual license, pornography, masturbation, contraception, abortion, infanticide, polygamy, adultery, homosexual acts, divorce, slavery, human trafficking, mercy killing and elective suicide. Gradually, the divine truth and love of the Holy Spirit, at work in Jesus' disciples and people of good will, was able to transform society into a Western civilization marked by a Judeo-Christian world view of human dignity, inalienable rights and Christian values. From the time of the fall of Adam and Eve, sin has always been at work in the human heart, but, for many centuries, the fruits of redemption in Jesus Christ were on the ascendency. In recent centuries, typified by events like the "reign of terror" in France, circa 1789, in a period of time called "modern" and "post modern" by contemporary historians, certain ideologies such as individualism, secular humanism, (read, practical atheism), and relativism (read, truth? What is truth?), have gradually permeated Western culture. The abuse of mass media and the political and judicial processes have accelerated both, confusion about, and hostility toward, the God-given meaning of human life, marriage and family. The Catholic-Christian world view has once again become a persecuted minority. In the last century the rise of totalitarian regimes in Japan, Germany, Russia, China (etc.) demonstrated how man-centered ideologies about the meaning of human life, could wreak havoc on marriages, families and society through coercive propaganda, power-politics and war. Tragically, many in the USA have capitulated to the same man-centered perspective (read, state of original sin). The U.S. government is one of the main promoters of sterilization, contraceptive birth control and "abortion as a human right" throughout the world. U. S. companies are also the greatest exporters and importers of pornography in the history of mankind. In the next Pastor's Corner we will try to shine the light of Christ on some of the most important questions on sexual morality that affect individuals, marriages and families: why pornography and masturbation are wrong; why contraception is wrong; and the benefits of natural family planning. Let us take Jesus' words to heart: "In the world you will have trouble, but take courage, I have conquered the world." (John 16:33) More to come.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

El Amor Es Nuestra Misión – La Familia Plenamente Viva. Parte 6: LUZ EN UN MUNDO OSCURO. Cuando la Iglesia fue fortalecida por el Espíritu Santo en Pentecostés hace casi 2,000 años, las culturas dominantes y paganas eran la Greca y Romana quienes estaban impregnadas de actitudes que aprobaban la licencia sexual, la pornografía, la masturbación, la anticoncepción, el aborto, el infanticidio, la poligamia, el adulterio, los actos homosexuales, el divorcio, la esclavitud, la trata de personas, la eutanasia y el suicidio. Poco a poco, la verdad divina y el amor del Espíritu Santo, han ido obrando en los discípulos de Jesús y la gente de buena voluntad, quienes fueron capaces de transformar la sociedad en una civilización Occidental, marcada por una visión del mundo Judeo-Cristiano de la dignidad humana, de derechos inalienables y de valores cristianos. Desde el momento de la caída de Adán y Eva, el pecado siempre ha estado obrando en el corazón humano, pero, por muchos siglos, los frutos de la redención en Jesucristo han ido en ascenso. En los últimos siglos, caracterizados como el "reino del terror" en Francia, alrededor de 1789, en un periodo de tiempo llamado "moderno" y "post moderno" por historiadores contemporáneos, con ciertas ideologías como el individualismo, humanismo secular, (leer, ateísmo práctico), y relativismo (leer, ¿verdad? ¿Qué es la verdad?), poco a poco se han impregnado en la cultura Occidental. El abuso de los medios de comunicación y los procesos políticos y judiciales han acelerado tanto confusión como hostilidad hacia el significado Divino de la vida humana, el matrimonio y la familia. La visión del mundo Católico-Cristiano una vez más se ha convertido en una minoría perseguida. En el siglo pasado, el ascenso de los regímenes totalitarios en Japón, Alemania, Rusia, China, (etc.) han demostrado cómo ideologías centradas por el hombre, acerca de la vida humana, pueden causar estragos en matrimonios, en familias y en la sociedad a través de propaganda coactiva, el poder-político y la guerra. Por desgracia, muchas personas en los Estados Unidos de América han capitulado la misma perspectiva centrada por el hombre (leer, estado de pecado original). El gobierno estadounidense es uno de los promotores principales de esterilización, el uso de anticonceptivos para el control de la natalidad, y el "aborto como un derecho humano" en todo el mundo. Las compañías estadounidenses también son los mayores exportadores e importadores de la pornografía en la historia de la humanidad. En el siguiente Rincón del Párroco trataremos de sobresaltar la luz de Cristo en algunas de las preguntas más importantes acerca de la moralidad sexual que afecta a individuos, matrimonios y familias: ¿Por qué la pornografía y la masturbación son incorrectas?, ¿por qué la anticoncepción es incorrecta?; además de los beneficios de la planificación familiar natural. Tomemos las palabras de Jesús de corazón: "En el mundo encontrarán dificultades, pero tengan ánimo, Yo he vencido al mundo." (Juan 16:33). Más por venir
