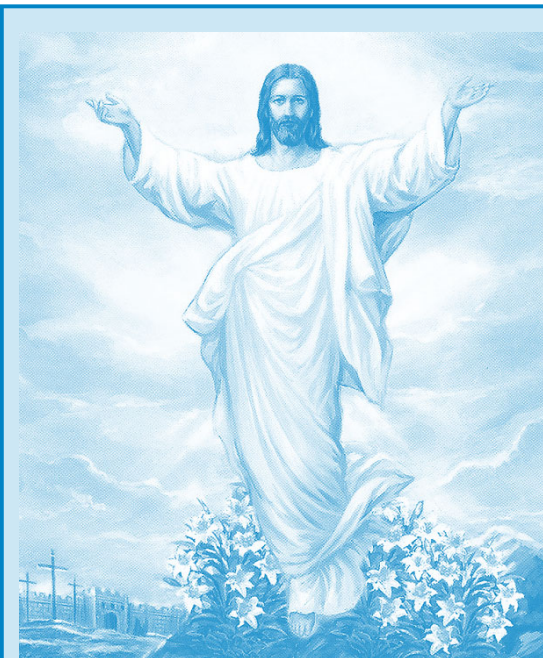

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Love Is Our Mission: The Family Fully Alive.** (Part 2 – The Mission of Love) “God works through us. We have a mission. We are in the world for a purpose – to receive God’s love ourselves and to show God’s love to others. God seeks to heal a broken universe. He asks us to be his witnesses and helpers in that work. p.25 (...) We have been created for communion. (...) God’s covenant is a central theme of Scripture, and marriage is the Bible’s privileged metaphor for describing God’s relationship with humanity. P.26 (...) God’s covenant fidelity teaches what love is. God never discards Israel for a more appealing partner. Nor is he deterred by rejection. He is never fickle. He wills only the best, the true and ultimate good for his people. And while his love for Israel is passionate with desire – (...) this ‘erotic’ aspect to divine love is always leavened with God’s sacrificial fidelity. God’s *eros* always integrates with his compassion and patience. God’s love is captured vividly in Ephesians 5, where Saint Paul extends the marriage analogy to Christ and the Church. Paul urges both husbands and wives to ‘be subject to one another out of reverence for Christ.’ (Eph.5:21) Christian marriage is therefore not a negotiation over rights and responsibilities, but rather a description of mutual self-giving. It is far more radical than mere egalitarianism. Paul does write that ‘the husband is the head of the wife just as Christ is the head of the church. (Eph. 5:23) But, in this metaphor, Paul calls husbands to a self-giving love that mirrors Christ’s sacrifice on the cross. (...) Drawing on Ephesians 5, the Church speaks of marriage as a sacrament, and summons couples to this kind of cruciform self-sacrificial communion. (p.28-29) For many today, ‘love’ is little more than a warm feeling or physical attraction. These things have their place. But, real love – love that endures and deepens and satisfies the human heart over a lifetime – grows from what we give to others, not from what we take for ourselves. p.30 Love is our mission, and our unity in Christ, especially as married couples and families, is the critical evidence that will draw people to Jesus as Lord and Savior. (Jn. 17:21) More to come.

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**El Amor Es Nuestra Misión – La Familia Plenamente Viva.** (Parte 2 – La Misión del Amor) “Dios obra a través de nosotros. Nosotros tenemos una misión. Estamos en el mundo con un propósito – recibir el amor de Dios y demostrar el amor de Dios a los demás. Dios busca sanar un universo quebrantado. Nos pide que seamos sus testigos y ayudantes en esa obra. P.25 (...) Hemos sido creados para la comunión. (...) La alianza de Dios es un tema central de la Sagrada Escritura, y el matrimonio es la metáfora privilegiada de la Biblia que describe la relación de Dios con la humanidad. P.26 (...) La fidelidad de la alianza de Dios enseña lo que es el amor. Dios nunca descarta a Israel por un compañero más atractivo. Tampoco se desalienta con el rechazo. Nunca es caprichoso. Solo desea lo mejor, el bien máximo y verdadero para su pueblo. Y mientras su amor por Israel se apasiona con el deseo – (...) este aspecto “erótico” del amor divino está siempre impregnado con fidelidad de Dios ofrecida en sacrificio. El *eros* de Dios se integra siempre con su compasión y paciencia. El amor de Dios está capturado vivamente en Efesios 5, donde San Pablo extiende la analogía del matrimonio a Cristo y la Iglesia. Pablo urge a los esposos a que ‘expresen respeto a Cristo siendo sumisos los unos a los otros.’ (Efesios 5:21) El matrimonio Cristiano no es, por consiguiente, una negociación por los derechos y las responsabilidades, sino una desripción de una entrega mutua. Es mucho más radical que el simple igualitarismo. Pablo escribe que ‘el hombre es cabeza de la mujer, como Cristo es cabeza de la Iglesia. (Efesios 5:23) Pero, en esta metáfora, Pablo llama a los maridos a un amor de entrega de sí mismos que refleje el sacrificio de Cristo en la cruz. (...) Valiéndose de Efesios 5, la Iglesia habla del matrimonio como un sacramento y convoca a las parejas a este tipo de comunión cruciforme. (p.28-29) Hoy para muchos, el “amor” es poco nada mas que un sentimiento cariñoso o una atracción física. Estas cosas tienen su lugar. Pero el amor real – el amor que dura y profundiza, y satisface el corazón humano a lo largo de la vida – crece a partir de lo que damos a los demás, no de lo que tomamos para nosotros mismos. (p.30) El amor es nuestra misión, y nuestra unidad en Cristo, especialmente en los matrimonios y familias, es una prueba esencial que atraerá a la gente a Jesús como Señor y Salvador. (Jn. 17:21). Más por venir.
