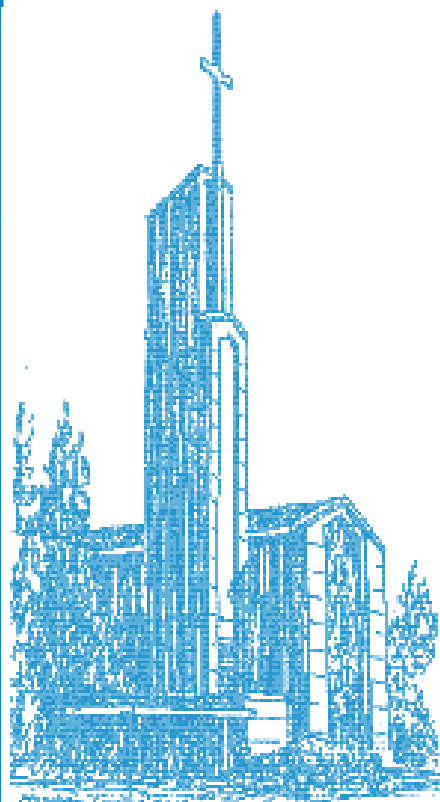

PASTOR'S CORNER

“We exist for the praise of his glory! (Eph. 1:12)

Recently I have been meditating on a comparison that fills me with reverent awe. Perhaps it will bring the same blessing to you. (Part I) It fills me with wonder and awe to recall boarding jumbo jets in years past and flying thousands of miles from California to the Philippines or to Singapore/India. A fully loaded Boeing 747 weighs about 500 tons, and yet it flies!
