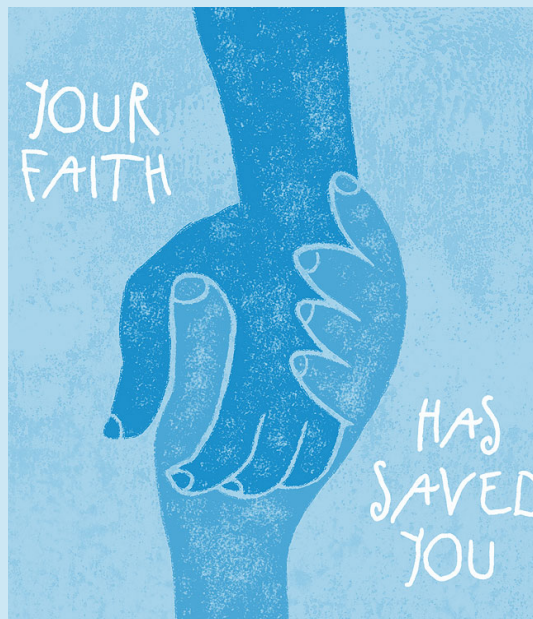

PASTOR'S CORNER

Love Is Our Mission: Family Fully Alive. Real love demands sacrifice for another, and that understanding isn't too popular. It doesn't hold forth the prospect of happy feelings or earthly rewards. It means getting up and going to work to support a family. It means giving up those personal pleasures that are taken at the expense of a wife and children. In short it means dying to self. But, after all, is there any place where Jesus told us that love would be easy? Looked at in this light, is abstinence out of line with the expectations Christians should have for their marriages? There is nothing wrong with celebrating your love for your spouse sexually. God certainly intended this as one of the blessings of married life, however, our sexual lives should honor His role in the creation of new life. **Contraceptive sex** does not reflect a reverence for God's dominion in this part of our lives. It does not renew your marriage covenant.. Instead it says, "I take you for better but definitely not for the imagined "worse" of possible pregnancy." We might say that we are "open to life" over the course of marriage, that the children we do allow to be conceived and born are sufficient evidence of generosity. We may have noble intentions, but reality betrays them. Let's face it, our estimate of our future wealth and capabilities tends to be much more pessimistic than God's. Faith tells us that God can do anything; His power is limitless. If we take absolute control over determining family size through contraception, we will tend to limit our children to a "comfortable" number. Faith just doesn't come into it. The same could happen with NFP, but more often couples who practice NFP have larger than average families. This is not because their method of family planning failed. Our experience at the Couple to Couple League is that using NFP coaxes people into a greater generosity when it comes to having children. They commonly start using NFP to avoid conception, but soon they lose their fears about pregnancy. Having worked with God to postpone pregnancy, they are more receptive to his prompting when He wants to bless them with children. Conscious of their children as true gifts of the Lord, perhaps they are better able to experience joy in the company of their children. RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

El Amor Es Nuestra Misión: La Familia Plenamente Viva. El verdadero amor exige sacrificio de uno para el otro, y ese entendimiento no muy popular. No mantiene la perspectiva de sentimientos de felicidad o de recompensas terrenales. Significa levantarse e ir a trabajar para mantener una familia. Significa renunciar a los placeres personales que se toman a expensas de una esposa e hijos. En pocas palabras, significa morir a uno mismo. Pero, después de todo, ¿existe algún lugar donde Jesús nos dice que el amor sería fácil? Desde ese punto de vista, ¿está la abstinencia fuera de lo normal con las expectativas que los cristianos deberían tener para sus matrimonios? No tiene nada de malo celebrar el amor por tu cónyuge sexualmente. Ciertamente, Dios pensó en esto como una de las bendiciones de la vida matrimonial, sin embargo, nuestra vida sexual debe honrar Su papel en la creación de una nueva vida. **El Sexo con el uso de anticonceptivos** no refleja una reverencia para el dominio de Dios en esta parte de nuestras vidas. No renueva su alianza matrimonial. En su lugar dice: "Te tomo para mejor, pero definitivamente no quiero imaginar la "peor" posibilidad de un embarazo." Podríamos decir que estamos "abiertos a la vida" en el transcurso del matrimonio, que los niños que permitimos concebir y nacer son pruebas suficientes generosidad. Pueden tener nobles intenciones, pero la realidad los traiciona. Seamos realistas, nuestro estimado de nuestra riqueza futura y capacidad tiende a ser mucho más pesimista que el de Dios. La fe nos dice que Dios puede hacer todo; Su poder es ilimitado. Si tomamos el control absoluto sobre la determinación del tamaño de la familia a través de la anticoncepción, tenderemos a limitar a nuestros hijos a un número "cómodo". La fe simplemente no entra en eso. Lo mismo podría ocurrir con la PFN, pero frecuentemente las parejas que practican la PFN tienen familias más grandes que el promedio. Esto no es debido a que su método de planificación familiar falló. Nuestra experiencia con la Liga de Pareja a Pareja que usa la PFN coacciona a la gente a una mayor generosidad a la hora de tener hijos. Por lo general, comienzan a usar la PFN para evitar la concepción, pero pronto pierden sus temores sobre el embarazo. Después de haber trabajado con Dios para posponer el embarazo, son más receptivos a su mensaje cuando Él quiere bendecirlos con niños. Conscientes que sus hijos son verdaderos dones del Señor, tal vez son más capaces de experimentar la alegría en compañía de sus hijos. ("De Hombre a Hombre" por la Liga de Pareja a Pareja) Más por venir.
