PASTOR'S CORNER

The Meaning of the Mass – The Opening Prayer

The priest stretches out his arms, says or sings, "Let us pray," and then pauses. **This short pause is critical.** It's the moment when we should be identifying before God our most pressing needs and intentions. The priest then collects all these silent prayers of the heart into a solemn opening prayer which follows an established pattern: (1) God is addressed using one or more of his titles, (2) we remember and acknowledge a saving event that God has done on our behalf, and (3) we ask for something in the present for ourselves and for the whole Church and world. When we remember what God has done in the past, we have courage and reason to hope for what we ask for in the present. In the final movement of this pattern of prayer, all that **we ask the Father** is asked **through the Son** and **in the Holy Spirit**. In this pattern we have the shape or pattern of prayer that will mark all the praying of the Mass. (adapted from, What Happens at Mass, by Jeremy Driscoll, OSB). Let us pray...

El sacerdote extiende sus brazos, y dice o canta, “Oremos,” y después hace una pausa. **Esta breve pausa es crítica.** Es el momento cuando deberíamos identificar ante Dios nuestras necesidades e intenciones más apremiantes. Entonces el sacerdote colecta todas estas oraciones silenciosas del corazón en una oración de apertura solemne la cual sigue un patrón ya establecido: (1) Nos dirigimos a Dios usando uno o más de sus títulos, (2) recordamos y reconocemos un acontecimiento salvífico que Dios ha hecho en nuestro nombre, y (3) pedimos algo en el presente para nosotros, para toda la Iglesia y para el mundo. Cuando recordamos lo que Dios ha hecho en el pasado, tenemos el valor y la razón para confiar por lo que pedimos en el presente. El en último paso de este patrón de oración, todo lo que **le pedimos al Padre** se le pide por **medio del Hijo** y en nombre **del Espíritu Santo.** En este patrón tenemos la forma o el modelo de oración en que se marcan todas las oraciones de la Misa.
