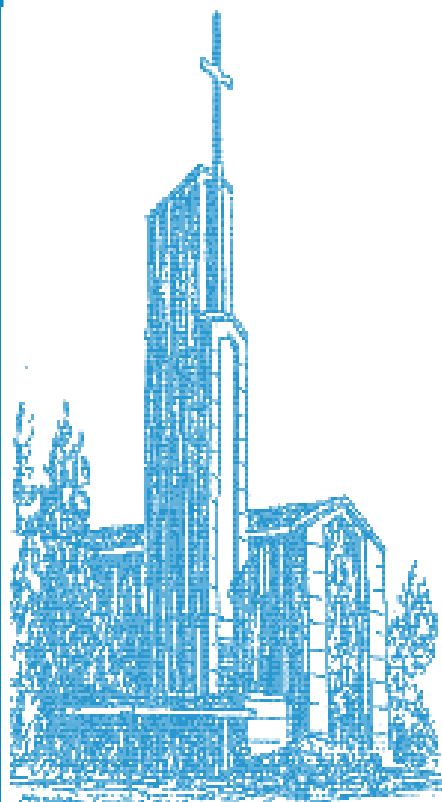

PASTOR'S CORNER

New Year – New Evangelization

To be deeply evangelized means to be able to say with St. Paul, "It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me. I still live my human life, but it is a life of faith in the Son of God who loved me and laid down his life for me (Gal. 2:20)." I know that when I say this, I have to honestly acknowledge a gap between the meaning of the words and the reality of my life. I must admit my need to be more deeply evangelized. What about you?

Blessed Pope John Paul II reminded every member of the Church of our need to be more deeply evangelized in his document, As the New Millennium Begins when he wrote, "We must rekindle in ourselves the impetus of the beginning (referring to Pentecost). ...We must allow ourselves to be filled anew with the ardor of the apostolic preaching (referring to The Acts of the Apostles). ...We must revive in ourselves the burning conviction of St. Paul who said, "Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel."

My dear brothers and sisters in Christ, let us move together into the New Year with new resolve to be more deeply evangelized ourselves so that we may participate more fully in the Church's mission to "make disciples" by evangelizing others. Why not plan on our New Year's Eve bilingual Mass and Holy Hour, 8 -10 PM in the Church on 12/31/13, and/or on our special bilingual 10 AM Mass on New Year's Day which, though not a holy day of obligation, is the Solemnity of Mary the Mother of God?
