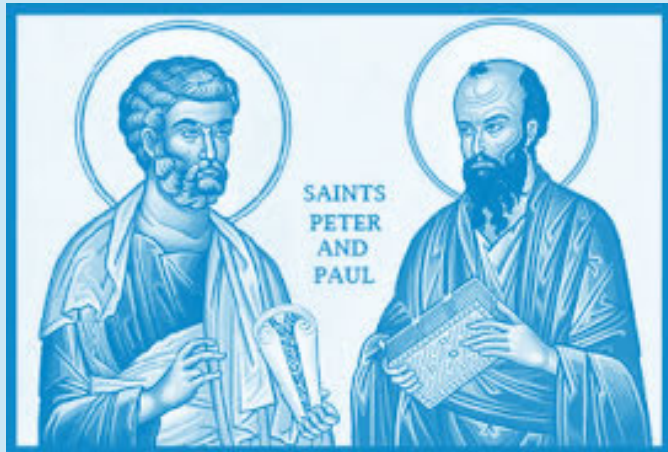

**Solemnity of Saints Peter and Paul.** On this annual Solemnity, the Church praises and thanks the Lord for the Gift of Apostolic Authority, Magisterial Teaching and the Charism of Infallibility for the benefit of Christians and all mankind to the end of time. It's war! Our adversary is the father of lies. In a world wounded by sin and vitiated by ignorance, confusion and outright lies, Jesus enables us to build our lives on ROCK. Saints Peter and Paul are icons of how Jesus' promise of the Spirit of Truth continues to guard and guarantee the truths of what we are to believe (Faith) and how we are to live (Morals) in the post Ascension-Pentecost Church.
