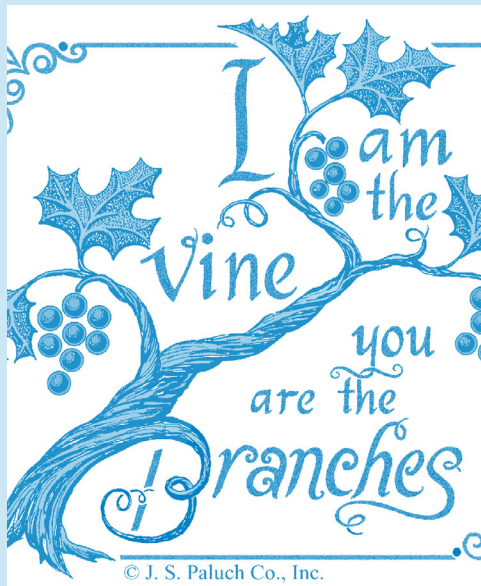

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**Love Is Our Mission: The Family Fully Alive.** “Part 3: The Meaning of Human Sexuality. Material creation has spiritual meaning. (...) The two sexes literally en-flesh God’s design for human interdependence, community and openness to new life. (...) Sex is a uniquely powerful factor in human affairs – both for good and for ill. And so sexuality misused or disordered has always been a major source of confusion and sin. (...) Marriage exists because we discover and accept, rather than invent or renegotiate, the vocation to self-giving which is intrinsic to being created male and female under the covenant. P.34. (...) At the center of this call to love is God’s summons to ‘be fruitful and multiply.’ (Gen. 1:28) A couple’s spousal union is therefore, by its very nature, also a call to live as father and mother. p.35. (...) Chastity is expressed in different ways, according to whether or not we are married. But, for everyone, chastity involves refusing to use our own or other people’s bodies as objects for consumption. Chastity is the habit, whether we are married or not, of living our sexuality with dignity and grace in the light of God’s commandments. Lust is the opposite of chastity. Lust involves looking at others in utilitarian ways, as if the other’s body existed merely to satisfy an appetite. True chastity ‘does not disdain the body’ but sees the body in the full dimensions of personhood. Chastity is a great ‘yes’ to the truth of humanity created in the image of God and called to live in the covenant.” P.37 **Love Is Our Mission** is available in the St. Marelo Bookstore. **El Amor Es Nuestra Misión – La Familia Plenamente Viva.** “Parte 3: El Significado de la Sexualidad Humana. La creación material tiene un significado espiritual, (...) Literalmente, los dos sexos encarnan el designio de Dios de independencia humana, comunidad y apertura a una vida nueva. (...) El sexo es un factor excepcionalmente poderoso en los asuntos humanos – tanto para el bien como para el mal. Y, por lo tanto, la sexualidad desordenada o usada incorrectamente ha sido siempre una fuente principal de confusión y pecado. (...) El matrimonio existe porque descubrimos y aceptamos, antes que inventar o renegociar la vocación de entrega de uno mismo, intrínseca al ser creado hombre y mujer bajo la alianza. P.34 (...) En el centro de este llamado a amar se encuentra esta convocatoria de Dios ‘sean fecundos y multiplíquense.’ (Gen. 1:28) Por consiguiente la unión conyugal de una pareja a través del cuerpo, por su misma naturaleza, es también un llamado a vivir como padre y madre. P.35. (...) La castidad se expresa de maneras diferentes, según estemos casados o no. Pero para todos, la castidad implica negarse a usar nuestro propio cuerpo o el de otras personas como objetos para el consumo. La castidad es el hábito, ya sea que estemos casados o no, de vivir nuestra sexualidad con dignidad y gracia a la luz de los mandamientos de Dios. Lo opuesto a la castidad es la lujuria. La lujuria implica mirar a los demás de manera utilitaria, como si el cuerpo del otro existiera simplemente para satisfacer un apetito. La verdadera castidad ‘no conduce al desprecio del cuerpo’ pero ve al cuerpo en las dimensiones enteras de la condición humana.
