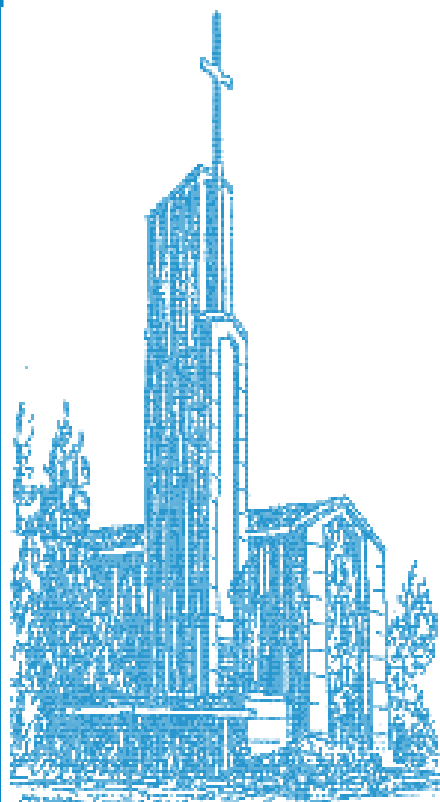

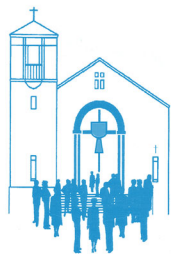

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

““Let prayer, **mercy** and fasting be one single plea to God on our behalf. ...Fasting bears no fruit unless it is watered by **mercy**. ...**Mercy** is to fasting as rain is to the earth. ...When you fast, if your **mercy** is thin, your harvest will be thin; when you fast, what you pour out in **mercy** will overflow into your barn. Therefore, do not lose by saving, but gather in by scattering. Give to the poor, and you give to yourself. You will not be allowed to keep what you have refused to give to others” (St. Peter Chrysologus). This week, out of the threefold unity of prayer, fasting and mercy, we will focus on **MERCY**. The concept of mercy is synonymous with almsgiving and generous stewardship. Indeed, in the classical list there are seven corporal and seven spiritual works of mercy, that is, fourteen ways for prayer and fasting to bear fruit in good deeds done for one's neighbor.

“Absorption in one's own interests causes the heart to grow hard and die. Let us pray: For those who are rich in this world's goods, that they may find blessing in generosity to the poor and hungry. ...For those who are rich in gifts of the mind, that they may find blessing in putting their abilities to work for the common good. ...For those who are rich in the gifts of the heart, that they may find blessing by loving those who are unlovable and unloved....O God, you loved the world so much that you gave your Only Begotten Son for our salvation. Grant that we who have received such a gift from you may withhold from those in need no gift that lies within our power to give, through Christ our Lord. Amen” (Magnificat Magazine, Morning Prayer, March 20, 2014). “**Blessed are the merciful, for they shall obtain mercy**” (Mt. 5:7).

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

*"Permite que la oración, la misericordia y el ayuno sean una sola súplica a Dios en nuestro nombre. ...El ayuno no da ningún fruto a menos que se riegue por la misericordia. ...La Misericordia es al ayuno como la lluvia a la tierra. ...Cuando ayunas, si tu misericordia es escasa, tu cosecha será escasa; cuando ayunas, lo que pones en misericordia se desbordará en tu granero. Por lo tanto, no te pierdas ahorrando, pero júntate en disparejamiento. Dale a los pobres, y date a ti mismo. No se te permitirá guardar lo que le has negado a los demás" (San Pedro Crisólogo). Esta semana, aparte de la triple unidad de oración, ayuno y misericordia, nos centraremos en MISERICORDIA. El concepto de misericordia es sinónimo de limosna y administración generosa. De hecho, en la lista clásica hay siete obras de misericordia corporal y siete de misericordia espiritual, es decir, catorce formas de oración y ayuno para dar fruto de buenas obras al prójimo.*

*"Absorción en los intereses propios causa que el corazón se endurezca y muera. Oremos: Por aquellos que son ricos con bienes materiales en este mundo para que puedan encontrar la bendición siendo generosos con los pobres y los hambrientos. ...Por aquellos que son ricos en dones de la mente, a fin de que encuentren la bendición de poner sus habilidades a trabajar por el bien común. ...Por aquellos que son ricos en los dones del corazón, para que puedan encontrar la bendición de amar a aquellos que son despreciados e ignorados. Oh Dios, amaste tanto al mundo que nos diste a tu Único Hijo Engendrado para nuestra salvación. Haz que nosotros que hemos recibido tal regalo que proviene de ti no les neguemos a los necesitados ningún regalo que este dentro de nuestro poder para dárselo., por Cristo nuestro Señor. Amén (Revista Magnificat, Oración Matutina, 20 de Marzo del 2014). "Bienaventurados los misericordiosos porque obtendrán la misericordia"*
