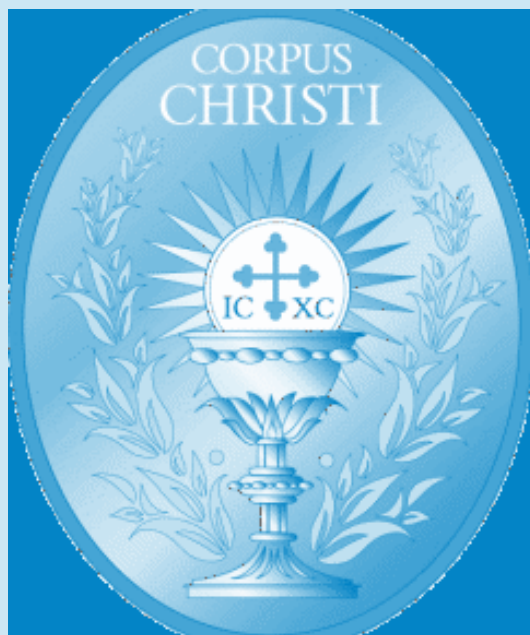

PASTOR'S CORNER

Love Is Our Mission: The Family Fully Alive PART 6 (cont.) **LIGHT IN A DARK WORLD.** "Speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way ... into Christ." (Eph. 4:15) Why are pornography, masturbation, pre-marital sex, adultery, and homosexual acts immoral? Sexual pleasure was created by God to accompany the free, total, faithful, open-to-new-life and mutual self-gift of husband and wife in a way that renews and expresses their marriage covenant. All forms of sexual immorality trivialize sexual arousal by moving the personal focus away from self-gift to a spouse in marriage and onto the lust of immediate self-gratification. Lust doesn't give; it takes. After the fleeting sexual pleasure fades away, lust leaves a feeling of shame and emptiness in its place. "Instead of merely inviting young people to be abstinent, St. John Paul II called them to *love chastity*, understanding it as a virtue that frees them to love in the image and likeness of God. When speaking to the youth of Uganda, he offered a succinct explanation of God's plan for human love and sexuality through the lens of the Theology of the Body: '*Essential to preparing for marriage is your vocation to chastity*. I know that young people reject hypocrisy. You want to be honest with yourselves and others. A chaste person is honest. (...) *Besides expressing ourselves through speech, we express ourselves through our bodies*. Sexual actions are "words" that reveal our hearts. *The Lord wants us to use our sexuality according to his plan*. (...) Honest sexual "language" requires a commitment to lifelong fidelity. To give your body to another person symbolizes the total gift of yourself to that person. But if you are not married, you are admitting that you might change your mind in the future. Total self-giving would then be absent. *Without the bond of marriage, sexual relations are a lie*. ... Do not be deceived by the empty words of those who ridicule chastity or your capacity for self control.' Many thought the Pope was being unrealistic by expecting teenagers to practice chastity. **The Pope, meanwhile, thought it was unrealistic to lead teenagers to believe they could find fulfillment outside of the will of God.**" (SAINT JOHN PAUL THE GREAT: His Five Loves by Jason Evert). Next week we will ask what's wrong with contraceptive birth control.

El Amor es Nuestra Misión: La Familia Plenamente

Viva Parte 6 (continuación) LUZ EN UN MUNDO OSCURO. "Viviendo con autenticidad el amor, crezcamos en todo... en Cristo." (Ef. 4:15) ¿Por qué la pornografía, la masturbación, el sexo prematrimonial, el adulterio y la homosexualidad son actos inmorales? El placer sexual fue creado por Dios para que fuese acompañado de ser libre, total, fiel, abierto-a-la-una-nueva-vida y a un mutuo auto-regalo de los esposos de una manera que renueve y exprese su alianza matrimonial. Todas las formas de inmoralidad sexual trivializan la excitación sexual alejando el enfoque personal de auto-regalo al cónyuge en el matrimonio y en la lujuria de auto-gratificación inmediata. La lujuria no da; solo toma. Después de que el placer sexual fugaz se desvanece, la lujuria deja una sensación de vergüenza y vacío en su lugar. "En lugar de simplemente invitar a los jóvenes a la abstinencia, San Juan Pablo II les llama a *amar a la castidad*, entendiéndola como una virtud que los libera a amar a imagen y semejanza de Dios. Mientras conversaba con la juventud de Uganda, ofreció una breve explicación acerca del plan de Dios para el amor humano y la sexualidad a través del lente de la Teología del Cuerpo: '*Tu vocación a la castidad es algo esencial para la preparación al matrimonio*. Sé que los jóvenes rechazan la hipocresía. Quieren ser honestos con ellos mismos y con los demás. Una persona casta es honesta. (...) *Además de expresarnos nosotros mismos a través del habla, nos expresamos a través de nuestros cuerpos*. Los actos sexuales son "palabras" que nuestros corazones revelan. *El Señor quiere que utilicemos nuestra sexualidad de acuerdo a su plan*. (...) El "Lenguaje" sexual honesto requiere de un compromiso a la fidelidad para toda la vida. Entregar tu cuerpo a otra persona simboliza la entrega total de sí mismo a esa persona. Pero si no está casado, está admitiendo que puede cambiar de opinión en el futuro. Entonces no habría una entrega total. *Sin el vínculo del matrimonio, las relaciones sexuales son una mentira*. ... No se deje engañar por las palabras vacías de los que ridiculizan la castidad o de su capacidad de autocontrol.' "Muchos pensaron que el Papa estaba siendo poco realista al esperar que los adolescentes practicaran la castidad. **Por su parte, el Papa, pensaba que era poco realista que los adolescentes crean que puedan encontrar satisfacción fuera de la voluntad de Dios**" (SAN JUAN PABLO EL GRANDE: Sus Cinco Amores por Jason Evert). La próxima semana nos preguntaremos ¿cuál es el problema del control de natalidad, los anticonceptivos?
