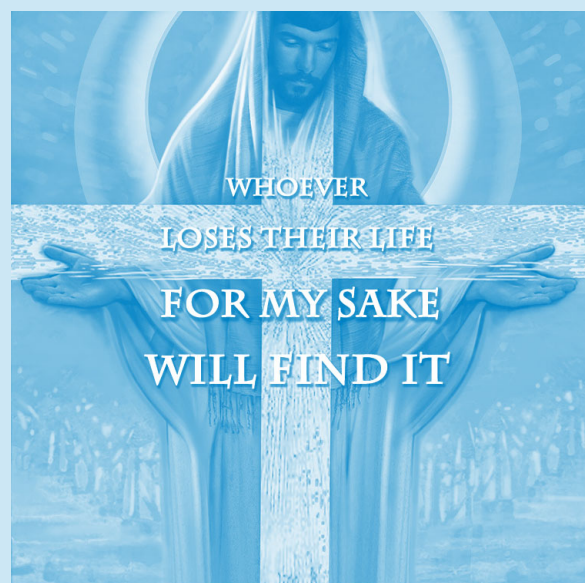
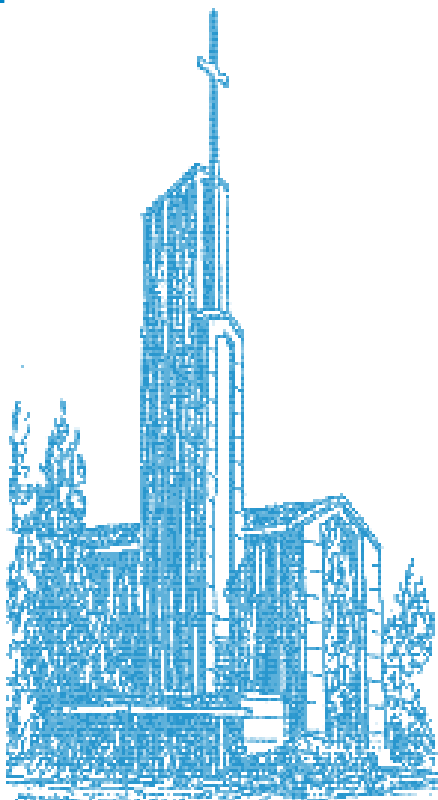

PASTOR'S CORNER

Laudato Si – Care for our Common Home. “This encyclical is aimed at everyone. Let us pray that everyone can receive its message and grow in responsibility toward the common home that God has entrusted to us.” (Pope Francis, Angelus, June 14, 2015). This past Winter, his Eminence Peter Cardinal Turkson came to Holy Spirit Church in Fresno to present a reflection on **Laudato Si** for the benefit of the Fresno Diocese. **Laudato Si** is an Encyclical Letter on Ecology, but not only on Ecology as it relates to caring for the health of our planet. Pope Francis stresses an Ecology that also cares for the dignity of every human being. Cardinal Turkson gave a fine overview of the Encyclical by synthesizing its content into SEVEN C’S. My purpose in summarizing the SEVEN C’S here is to encourage all of us to find time to read the Encyclical. By definition a Papal Encyclical is a Letter for every member of the Church. The title, “Laudato Si” is taken from a famous poem by Saint Francis of Assisi which praises God the Creator for His creation. Here are the Seven C’s:

1. **Continuity:** this Encyclical builds on the social teaching of Leo XIII, St. John XXIII, Blessed Paul VI, St. John Paul II and Benedict XVI.
2. **Collegiality:** the Encyclical teaches in solidarity with documents from many Episcopal Conferences from all over the world.
3. **Conversation** or Dialogue: Because there is an urgent global problem, there needs to be a conversation between Faith and Reason; between Religion and Science. Both Science and Religion are seeking Truth. They must walk together.
4. **Care for our common home:** Pope Francis uses the word, “CARE,” because it evokes devotion of the heart and commitment of the will. Care connotes passionate love. Responses to the cry of the Poor and to the cry of the Environment are inseparable. Use of technology requires the guidance of morality and ethics.
5. **Conversion:** an ecological conversion requires a change of heart, a change of attitude, a change of method. You cannot propose a change of heart without motivating people to do it. Therefore there is a role for education and spirituality.
6. **Citizenship:** There needs to be local responsibility, local input and subsidiarity. All are called to participate.
7. **Contemplation:** Prayer – a reverential relationship with the Creator will bring about reverence for all of creation.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Laudato Si – Cuidado sobre nuestra Casa Común.

“Esta encíclica está dirigida a todos. Oremos para que todos puedan recibir su mensaje y crecer en responsabilidad hacia la casa común que Dios nos ha confiado.” (Papa Francisco, Ángelus, 14 de Junio del 2015). Este pasado invierno, su Eminencia Peter Cardinal Turkson vino a la Iglesia del Espíritu Santo en Fresno para presentar una reflexión sobre Laudato Si para el beneficio de la Diócesis de Fresno. Laudato Si es una Carta Encíclica sobre Ecología, pero no sólo sobre Ecología ya que se refiere al cuidado de la salud de nuestro planeta. El Papa Francisco destaca una Ecología que también cuida de la dignidad de cada ser humano. El Cardenal Turkson dió un buen resumen de la Encíclica al sintetizar su contenido en Siete “C”s. Mi propósito al resumir las Siete “C”s aquí, es para animar a todos a encontrar tiempo para leer la Encíclica. Por definición, una Encíclica Papal es una Carta para cada miembro de la Iglesia. El título “Laudato Si” es tomado de un famoso poema de San Francisco de Asís que alaba a Dios el Creador por su creación. Aquí están las Siete “C”s:

1. **Continuidad:** esta Encíclica se basa en la enseñanza social de León XIII, San Juan XXIII, el Bienaventurado Pablo VI, San Juan Pablo II y Benedicto XVI.
2. **Colegialidad:** la Encíclica enseña en solidaridad con los documentos de muchas Conferencias Episcopales de todo el mundo.
3. **Conversación** o Diálogo: Debido a que existe un problema global urgente, es necesario que haya una conversación entre Fe y Razón; Entre Religión y Ciencia. Tanto la Ciencia como la Religión buscan la Verdad. Deben caminar juntos.
4. **Cuidado de nuestra casa común:** El Papa Francisco usa la palabra “CUIDADO” porque evoca la devoción del corazón y el compromiso de la voluntad. El cuidado conoce el amor apasionado. Las respuestas al grito de los Pobres y al grito del Medio Ambiente son inseparables. El uso de la tecnología requiere la orientación de la moral y la ética.
5. **Conversión:** una conversión ecológica requiere un cambio de corazón, un cambio de actitud, un cambio de método. No se puede proponer un cambio de corazón sin motivar a la gente a hacerlo. Por lo tanto, hay un papel para la educación y la espiritualidad.
6. **Ciudadanía:** Es necesario que haya responsabilidad local, contribuciones locales y subsidiariedad. Todos están llamados a participar.
7. **Contemplación:** Oración - una relación reverencial con el Creador traerá reverencia para toda la creación.
