PASTOR'S CORNER

A WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT (Part Three). God's Gift of Self is the cause of our joy. What is a practical way for me to receive this Gift, personally and profoundly, on a daily basis? Let us focus on the ever present promise of Jesus to all of his disciples: *"Behold, I stand at the door and knock; if anyone hears my voice and opens the door, I will come in to him and dine with him, and he with me"* (Rev. 3:20). The key word here is "dine." It means that Jesus wants to spend a **sufficient period of quality time** with me that includes some meaningful heart to heart conversation. In other words, I cannot dine with Jesus in just five minutes. A meaningful "dinner" with Jesus would take at least 15 to 30 minutes, and maybe longer, depending on circumstances. Another key word is "knock." Jesus is knocking on the door of my heart because he respects me. He refuses to treat me like a thing, a robot, or a computer. He refuses to just barge in. He is waiting for my free response to his loving initiative. So now the question becomes, Do I trust that, though invisible, Jesus is very close to me and that he is waiting for my response to his desire to spend time with me? Am I willing to use my freedom to make sufficient, daily, quiet, personal prayer time with Jesus a priority in my life? If so, this decision needs to be put into action today and every day. It needs to become a discipline, a habit, a virtue. Since the "tyranny of the urgent" tends to war against this habit of "wasting time" with Jesus, I have found the following proverb helpful in not allowing the "urgent" to rob me of "the most important:" *No Bible, No Breakfast!* In other words, If I do not have time to dine with Jesus, the Living Word of God, then I do not have time for breakfast either. This proverb motivates me to budget my time correctly in the morning. Next week I will share a practical way to "Dine with Jesus."

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

PALABRAS DE ANIMO (Tercera Parte) El don de sí mismo de Dios es la causa de nuestra alegría. ¿Cómo puedo yo recibir diariamente este don, personal y profundamente? Enfoquemonos siempre en la promesa presente de Jesús a todos sus discípulos: *"Mira que estoy de pie junto la puerta y llamo. Si alguno oye mi voz y abre la puerta, entraré en su casa y cenaré con él y él conmigo."* (Ap. 3:20) La palabra clave aquí es "cenar". Que significa que Jesús quiere pasar **un tiempo suficiente de calidad** conmigo que incluye una conversación significativa de corazón a corazón. En otras palabras, no puedo cenar con Jesús en tan sólo cinco minutos. Una "cena" significativa con Jesús tomaría por lo menos 15 a 30 minutos, y quizás más tiempo, dependiendo de las circunstancias. Otra palabra clave es "llamo". Jesús está llamando a la puerta de mi corazón porque me respeta. Se niega a tratarme como una cosa, un robot, o computadora. Se niega a interrumpir. Él está esperando mi respuesta libre a su iniciativa de amor. Así que ahora la pregunta es, ¿Confío en que, aunque invisible, Jesús está muy cerca de mí y que está esperando mi respuesta a su deseo de pasar tiempo conmigo? ¿Estoy dispuesto a utilizar mi libertad de tomar suficiente tiempo todos los días, de silencio, de oración personal con Jesús y que sea una prioridad en mi vida? Si es así, esta decisión debe ser puesta en acción hoy y todos los días. Debe convertirse en una disciplina, un hábito, una virtud. Dado que la "tiranía de lo urgente" tiende a la guerra contra este hábito de "perder el tiempo" con Jesús, he encontrado el siguiente proverbio útil para no permitir que la "urgente" robarme de "lo más importante": "¡No Biblia, No Desayuno!" En otras palabras, si no tengo tiempo para cenar con Jesús, la Palabra viva de Dios, entonces no tengo tiempo para el desayuno tampoco. Este proverbio me motiva a mí a calcular mi tiempo correctamente en la mañana. La semana que viene voy a compartir una forma práctica de "cenar con Jesús."
