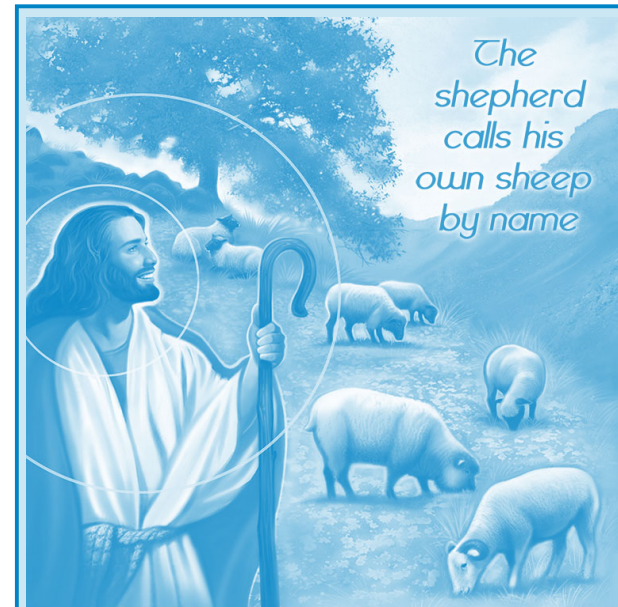

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**PRAY THE ROSARY DAILY!** In Fatima, Mary called herself, "Our Lady of the Rosary." She taught the children to add the following prayer after each Glory be: "*O my Jesus, forgive us our sins, save us from the fires of hell, and lead all souls to heaven, especially those who are in most need of thy mercy.*" Recall the theme of the Church's Jubilee Year of Mercy, "*Be merciful, even as your Father is merciful*" (Luke 6:36). The Jubilee Year was meant to remind us that we are in the final age of human history, which is the age of Divine Mercy. This final age runs from the time of Jesus' death, resurrection, ascension and out-pouring of the Holy Spirit to his coming on the clouds in glory and majesty to judge the living and the dead. Messages that came to the world through Our Lady of Fatima put emphasis on this same merciful heart of the Gospel. In our parish celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday, we used the rosary beads to help us pray the Chaplet of Divine Mercy. Then we used the rosary to help us focus on a new set of mysteries, the Merciful Mysteries. I encourage us all to incorporate these Merciful Mysteries into our daily discipline of praying the rosary, perhaps every Tuesday. Since they are "new," I list them here. You may wish to cut this Pastor's Corner out and stick it in your Bible for easy reference. **The Merciful Mysteries:** 1. Pardon of the Sinful Woman (Luke 7:44, 46-47). 2. The Father Forgives His Lost Son (Luke 15:20-24). 3. Jesus Forgives the Woman Caught in Adultery (John 8:6-11). 4. The Crucified Criminal Receives Mercy (Luke 23:39-43). 5. Jesus Institutes the Sacrament of Reconciliation (John 20:19-23). You may wish to use the following pattern for praying the rosary daily: Sunday – Glorious Mysteries; Monday-Joyful Mysteries; Tuesday-Merciful Mysteries; Wednesday-Glorious Mysteries; Thursday-Luminous Mysteries; Friday-Sorrowful Mysteries; Saturday-Joyful Mysteries.

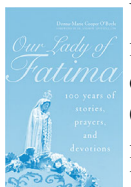

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**¡RECEN EL ROSARIO DIARIAMENTE!** En Fátima, María se llamó a sí misma “Nuestra Señora del Rosario”. Enseñó a los niños a añadir la siguiente oración después de cada Gloria: *“Oh Jesús mío, perdona nuestros pecados, libranos del fuego del infierno, lleva al cielo a todas las almas, especialmente a las más necesitadas de tu misericordia.”* Recordemos el lema del Año de la Misericordia del Jubileo de la Iglesia: “Sean misericordiosos, como su Padre es misericordioso.” (Lucas 6:36). El Año del Jubileo estaba destinado a recordarnos que estamos en la edad final de la historia humana, que es la era de la Divina Misericordia. Esta era final va desde el tiempo de la muerte de Jesús, la resurrección, la ascensión y el derramamiento del Espíritu Santo hasta su venida sobre las nubes en gloria y majestad para juzgar a los vivos y a los muertos. Los mensajes que llegaron al mundo a través de Nuestra Señora de Fátima pusieron énfasis en este mismo corazón misericordioso del Evangelio. En nuestra celebración parroquial del Domingo de la Divina Misericordia, usamos las cuentas de rosario para ayudarnos a orar la Coronilla de la Divina Misericordia. Luego usamos el rosario para ayudarnos a enfocarnos en un nuevo conjunto de misterios, los Misterios Misericordiosos. Animo a todos nosotros a incorporar estos Misterios Misericordiosos en nuestra disciplina diaria de rezar el rosario, tal vez todos los Martes. Ya que son “nuevos”, los listo aquí. Es posible que desee recortar este Rincón del Párroco y pegarlo en su Biblia para facilitar la referencia. **Los Misterios Misericordiosos:** 1. El perdón de la Mujer Pecadora (Lucas 7:44, 46-47). 2. El Padre Perdona a Su Hijo Perdido (Lucas 15: 20-24). 3. Jesús Perdona a la Mujer Atrapada en el Adulterio (Juan 8: 6-11). 4. El Criminal Crucificado Recibe Misericordia (Lucas 23: 39-43). 5. Jesús Instituye el Sacramento de la Reconciliación (Juan 20:19-23). Es posible que desee usar el siguiente orden para rezar el Rosario diariamente: Domingo–Misterios Gloriosos; Lunes–Misterios Gozosos, Martes–Misterios Misericordiosos; Miércoles–Misterios Gloriosos; Jueves Misterios–Luminosos; Viernes–Misterios Dolorosos; Sábado–Misterios Gozosos.
