PASTOR'S CORNER

EPIPHANY: "The Word of life was made visible... *what we have seen and heard we proclaim now to you, so that you too may have fellowship with us; for our fellowship is with the Father and with his son, Jesus Christ*" (1 John 1:2-3). **FELLOWSHIP - COMMUNION**, in the Trinity and in the Body of Christ - the Church; this is what the essence of Christianity and salvation is all about. "*We are writing this to you so that our joy may be complete*" (1 John 1:4). We were each created in the image and likeness of God who is Love. We were created to receive the Self Gift of God, and to give ourselves as self-gift to God and to one another. If we do this, then we have the FELLOWSHIP that is the essence of Christianity; the Peace that transcends understanding, and the Joy that is the fulfillment of all desire. In the recent Pastor's Corners I have been describing a practical way to make this FELLOWSHIP - COMMUNION with God and our fellow human beings part of our daily experience. I call it, **BREAKFAST WITH JESUS:** a minimum of thirty minutes that begins with: 1. Ten minutes of gratitude and praise as I get in touch with the gifts of creation, life, redemption and blessings of the last 24 hours; 2. Ten minutes of confiding my difficulties, needs and questions to Jesus and listening for his counsels; and 3. Ten minutes of praying with compassion for special intentions, my family, the poor, the needy, the sick, the Church, and all my fellow human beings on the face of the earth and in purgatory. Allow me to elaborate on #3. Jesus commands us and enables us to love one another as He has loved us. Jesus intercedes for us. St. Paul exhorts us to pray for one another, which is one of the important expressions of this love that the Father and Jesus pour into our hearts (see Romans 5:5). "*Pray at all times in the Spirit, with all prayer and supplication. To that end, keep alert with all perseverance, interceding for all the saints, and for me...*" (Ephesians 6:18). Some practical ways to accomplish course # 3 in the daily BREAKFAST WITH JESUS is to keep a written list of names for whom you are praying. One can use the Chaplet of Divine Mercy or even the Rosary to help manifest this work of mercy.

EPIFANÍA: " La Palabra de vida se hizo visible... lo que hemos visto y oído ahora proclamamos a ustedes por lo que también puedan tener comunión con nosotros; porque nuestra comunión es con el Padre y con su hijo, Jesucristo "(1 Juan 1:2-3). **COMUNIDAD - COMUNIÓN**, en la Trinidad y en el Cuerpo de Cristo - la Iglesia; es la esencia del cristianismo y la salvación. "Les estamos escribiendo esto para que nuestro gozo sea completo" (1 John 1:4). Cada uno de nosotros fuimos creados a imagen y semejanza de Dios que es amor. Fuimos creados para recibir el mismo regalo de Dios y entregarnos como auto regalo a Dios y el uno con el otro. Si hacemos esto, entonces tenemos la COMUNIDAD que es la esencia del Cristianismo, la paz que sobrepasa el entendimiento y la Alegría que es el cumplimiento de todo deseo. Diez minutos de confiar mis dificultades, necesidades y preguntas a Jesús y escuchar sus consejos; y 3. Diez minutos de oración con compasión por intenciones especiales, mi familia, los pobres, los necesitados, los enfermos, la iglesia y todos mis compañeros los seres humanos sobre la faz de la tierra y en el Purgatorio. Permítanme elaborar en #3. Jesús nos ordena y nos permite amarnos los unos a los otros como él nos ha amado. Jesús intercede por nosotros. San Pablo nos exhorta a orar por otros, que es una de las expresiones importantes de este amor que el Padre y Jesús nos llena nuestros corazones (Ver Romanos 5:5). "Oren en todo momento en el Espíritu con toda oración y súplica. Para ello, manténganse alertos con toda perseverancia, intercediendo por todos los Santos y por mí... " (Efesios 6:18). Algunas maneras prácticas de lograr curso # 3 en el diario Desayuno con Jesús es mantener una lista de nombres para los quienes están orando. Se puede utilizar la Coronilla a la Divina Misericordia o incluso el Rosario para ayudar a manifestar esta obra de misericordia
