PASTOR'S CORNER

The Paradox of Divine Mercy. *“Pray then like this, Our Father, ...forgive us our debts as we also have forgiven our debtors. ...For if you forgive men their trespasses, your heavenly Father will also forgive you; but if you do not forgive men their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses” (Mt. 6:13,14).* The resurrection of Jesus and his return to the sinful world that rejected him reveals the infinite Mercy of God. Yes, God so loved the world that He forgave the torture and crucifixion of his only-begotten Son. There is no greater sin than that and there is no greater mercy. Through Jesus Christ, the GIFT of Divine Mercy, forgiveness of sins and eternal life in Heaven are offered to every sinner from Adam and Eve to the end of time. But here's the rub: each of us must use our free will to believe this Good News, repent of our sins and RECEIVE the gift of forgiveness in order for the gift to do us any good. How can I be sure of my repentance and my belief in the Gospel? Jesus gives us the acid test: am I willing to forgive, without limit and from my heart, those fellow human beings who have hurt and offended me? Forgiveness means that I love my “enemy” by letting go of any desire for vengeance. Indeed, in spite of my wounds, I begin praying for my enemy's eternal good and salvation. Forgiveness does not mean that I forego my desire for justice, healing, reparation and reconciliation. ***Be merciful even as your Heavenly Father is merciful*** (Lk.6:36). Seem impossible? More next week.

Fasting: Catholics between the ages of 18 to 59 are obligated to eat only one full meal, and, if necessary to maintain strength, two smaller meals not equaling a full meal. No snacking in between meals.

Abstinence: Catholics 14 years old and above are to abstain from meat. Eating meat from any mammal (e.g., beef, pork) or bird (e.g., chicken, turkey) is not permitted. Fish and other seafood are allowed.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

La Paradoja de la Divina Misericordia. “Ora entonces así, Padre Nuestro, ...perdona nuestras deudas así como nosotros perdonamos a nuestros deudores. ...Que si tu perdonas a las ofensas de los hombres también el Padre celestial te las perdonará; en cambio si no perdonas las ofensas de los hombres, tampoco el Padre celestial se las perdonará a ustedes” (Mt. 6:1,14). La resurrección de Jesús y su regreso al mundo pecaminoso que lo rechazó revela la infinita Misericordia de Dios. Sí, tanto amó Dios al mundo que Él perdonó la tortura y la crucifixión de su Hijo único-engendrado. No hay mayor pecado que eso y no hay mayor misericordia.
