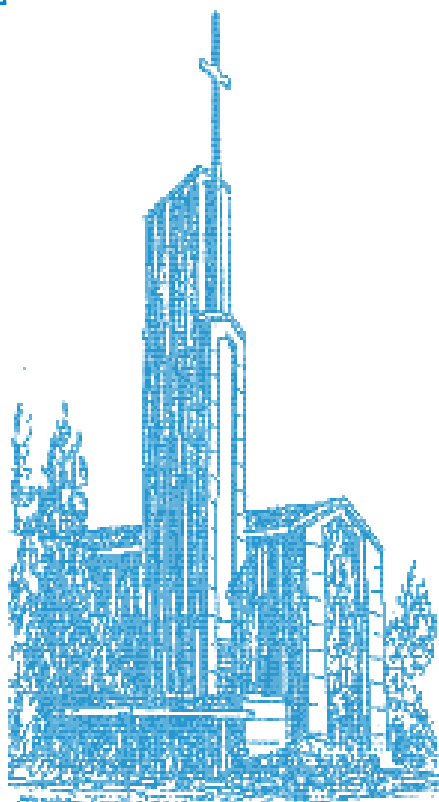

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**PRAY THE ROSARY DAILY!** This coming Thursday is July 13, 2017. It will mark the 100<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of the Third Apparition of Our Lady of Fatima to the three shepherd children in Portugal. That evening, Fr. Gustavo will be providing a teaching on the "three secrets of Fatima" at 6:30 PM in Rm. 42. For the sake of world peace, one of the most pressing exhortations of Our Lady of Fatima is to **pray the rosary daily**, as an individual or, better yet, as a family or, as a parish group. As we know, the rosary is a powerful prayer form that helps us to meditate on the principal mysteries of our salvation, for the transformation of our minds and our hearts. It is also a spiritual work of mercy in which we ask Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and Mary, to pray with us and for us, for special intentions and for the needs of all our fellow poor sinners, on the face of the earth and in purgatory. To aid in this aspect of the rosary as a work of mercy, I have found it helpful to memorize five general intentions and to say one of them after the short meditation on the mystery, and just before praying the "Our Father." As an encouragement to you to come up with your own intentions that can be associated with each mystery, here are the ones that I use. **First Mystery:** For peace in our world, grounded in justice and tempered by mercy; for the conversion of poor sinners beginning with me; and for healing and reconciliation in all wounded relationships. **Second Mystery:** For conversion, healing and salvation for all who are being harmed in any way by sins against life, love, truth, goodness, marriage, family and the God-given meaning of human sexuality, and for the conversion of those who promote these evils. **Third Mystery:** In reparation for the sins of the medical profession, the scientific community and for sins that lead to economic and social injustice; for conversion, healing and salvation for those affected by these evils and for the conversion of those who promote these evils. **Fourth Mystery:** For all citizens, executives, legislators and judges; that human life may be protected, enhanced and brought to fulfillment under the law in our nation and in the world. **Fifth Mystery:** For the New Evangelization and the Evangelization of all Peoples; for the renewal of the Church in its clergy, religious life, dedicated single life, marriage and family; and for the renewal of the Oblates of St. Joseph-growth in holiness for those who have been called, and for new and holy vocations.

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**¡REZA EL ROSARIO DIARIAMENTE!** Este Jueves es el 13 de Julio del 2017. Será el Centenario de la Tercera Aparición de Nuestra Señora de Fátima a los tres niños pastorcitos de Portugal. Esa noche, el Padre Gustavo ofrecerá una enseñanza sobre los "tres secretos de Fátima" a las 6:30 pm en el salón 42. Por el bien de la paz mundial, una de las exhortaciones más urgentes de Nuestra Señora de Fátima es **rezar el rosario diariamente**, como individuo o, mejor aún, como familia o como grupo parroquial. Como sabemos, el rosario es una poderosa forma de oración que nos ayuda a meditar sobre los principales misterios de nuestra salvación, para la transformación de nuestras mentes y nuestros corazones. Es también una obra espiritual de misericordia en la que pedimos al Padre, al Hijo y al Espíritu Santo, y a María, que oren con nosotros y por nosotros, por intenciones especiales y por las necesidades de todos los pobres pecadores, sobre la faz de la tierra, y en el purgatorio. Para ayudar en este aspecto del rosario como una obra de misericordia, he encontrado útil memorizar cinco intenciones generales y decir una de ellas después de la breve meditación sobre el misterio, y justo antes de orar el "Padre Nuestro". Para animarte a llegar a tus propias intenciones que se pueden asociar con cada misterio, aquí están los que yo uso. **Primer Misterio:** Por la paz en nuestro mundo, fundada en la justicia y templada por la misericordia; por la conversión de pobres pecadores comenzando por mí mismo; y por la sanación y la reconciliación en todas las relaciones heridas. **Segundo Misterio:** Por la conversión, la sanación y la salvación para todos los que están siendo dañados de cualquier manera por los pecados contra la vida, el amor, la verdad, la bondad, el matrimonio, la familia y el significado dado por Dios de la sexualidad humana y por la conversión de aquellos que promueven estas maldades. **Tercer Misterio:** En reparación por los pecados de la profesión médica, la comunidad científica y por los pecados que conducen a la injusticia económica y social; por la conversión, la sanación y la salvación de aquellos afectados por estos males y para la conversión de aquellos que promueven estas maldades. **Cuarto Misterio:** Por todos los ciudadanos, ejecutivos, legisladores y jueces; para que la vida humana pueda ser protegida, mejorada y llevada al cumplimiento bajo la ley en nuestra nación y en el mundo. **Quinto Misterio:** Por la Nueva Evangelización y la Evangelización de todos los Pueblos; por la renovación de la Iglesia de su clero, vida religiosa, dedicada vida soltera, matrimonio y familia; y por la renovación de los Oblatos de San José, crecimiento en santidad para aquellos que han sido llamados, y para vocaciones nuevas y santas.
