PASTOR'S CORNER

LISTEN TO OUR LADY OF FATIMA. Tuesday, June 13, will mark the 100th anniversary of the second apparition of our Blessed Mother to the three shepherd children. Repent from all sin. Pray the rosary daily. Sacrifice, make reparation and intercede for the conversion of poor sinners. Are we listening? Are we obeying? In October of 1917 Russia became dominated by the ideology of atheistic communism and began to spread her errors through the establishment of the Soviet Union. On June 13, 1929, Mary specifically asked through Sr. Lucia, one of the seers of Fatima, that Russia be consecrated to her Immaculate Heart by the Pope in union with all the bishops of the world as a means to world peace. On March 25, 1984, the Feast of the Annunciation, St. John Paul II, in union with All the Bishops of the World, made a "Consecration of all Individuals and Peoples of the World to the Immaculate Heart of Mary." In August of 1989, Sr. Lucia, affirmed in correspondence that the consecration has been accomplished and that God will keep his word. History shows that the response of members of the Church to the call to conversion has been, at best, slow and partial. Even so, we can marvel at the fruits of the obedience of a faithful remnant. In 1990 Alexy II became the first Russian Patriarch since the Communist Revolution to be elected without direct interference of the government. On December 25, 1991, the Union of Soviet Socialist Republics was dissolved. In 1987 there were three monasteries in Russia, today there are more than 478. In 1987 there were 2 seminaries in Russia. Today there are more than 25. In 1987 there were 2,000 parish churches in Russia. Now there are more than 13,000. 60% of Russians profess to be members of the Russian Orthodox Church. At this time only 10% attend services regularly. The call to conversion is more timely and important than ever. How is my response?

ESCUCHA A NUESTRA SEÑORA DE FATIMA. El Martes 13 de Junio se marcará el centenario de la segunda aparición de nuestra Santísima Madre a los tres niños. Arrepiéntanse de todo pecado. Recen el rosario diariamente. Sacrifica, repara e intercede por la conversión de los pobres pecadores. ¿Estamos escuchando? ¿Estamos obedeciendo? En Octubre de 1917 Rusia fué dominada por la ideología del comunismo ateo y comenzó a difundir sus errores a través del establecimiento de la Unión Soviética. El 13 de Junio de 1929, María pidió específicamente a Sor Lucía, una de las videntes de Fátima, que Rusia fuera consagrada a su Inmaculado Corazón por el Papa en unión con todos los obispos del mundo como medio para la paz mundial. El 25 de Marzo de 1984, en la fiesta de la Anunciación, San Juan Pablo II, en unión con todos los Obispos del mundo, hizo una "Consagración de todos los individuos y pueblos del mundo al Inmaculado Corazón de María." En 1989, Sor Lucia, afirmó en correspondencia que la consagración se ha cumplido y que Dios guardará su palabra. La historia muestra que la respuesta de los miembros de la Iglesia al llamado a la conversión ha sido, en el mejor de los casos, lenta y parcial. Aun así, podemos maravillarnos de los frutos de la obediencia de un remanente fiel. En 1990 Alexy II fué el primer Patriarca Ruso desde la Revolución comunista en ser elegido sin interferencia directa del gobierno. El 25 de Diciembre de 1991 se disolvió la Unión de Repúblicas Socialistas Soviéticas. En 1987 había tres monasterios en Rusia, hoy hay más de 478. En 1987 había 2 seminarios en Rusia. Hoy en día hay más de 25. En 1987 había 2,000 iglesias parroquiales en Rusia. Ahora hay más de 13,000. El 60% de los Rusos profesan ser cristianos, miembros de la Iglesia Ortodoxa Rusa. En este momento sólo el 10% asiste a los servicios regularmente. La llamada a la conversión es más oportuna e importante que nunca. ¿Cómo es mi respuesta?
