PASTOR'S CORNER

"Nine- Eleven, 2001," a date that will live on in infamy! What a horrific terrorist attack! Close to 3,000 innocent people were murdered in one day. The peace and feeling of security in our own nation hasn't been the same since. What can be done? What ought to be done to defeat evil and restore peace? Let us draw upon the wisdom, love and courage of the Church's newest saint, St. Mother Teresa of Calcutta. On February 3, 1994 she addressed the leaders of our country in Washington, D.C. at the National Prayer Breakfast.

"But I feel that the greatest destroyer of peace today is abortion, because it is a war against the child, a direct killing of the innocent child, murder by the mother herself.

And if we accept that a mother can kill even her own child, how can we tell other people not to kill one another? How do we persuade a woman not to have an abortion? As always, we must persuade her with love and we remind ourselves that love means to be willing to give until it hurts. Jesus gave even His life to love us. So, the mother who is thinking of abortion, should be helped to love, that is, to give until it hurts her plans, or her free time, to respect the life of her child. The father of that child, whoever he is, must also give until it hurts.

By abortion, the mother does not learn to love, but kills even her own child to solve her problems.

And, by abortion, the father is told that he does not have to take any responsibility at all for the child he has brought into the world. That father is likely to put other women into the same trouble. So abortion just leads to more abortion.

Any country that accepts abortion is not teaching its people to love, but to use any violence to get what they want. This is why the greatest destroyer of love and peace is abortion."

In our parish office there is a bumper sticker that reads, "ABORTION... the ultimate TERRORISM! Over 5,000 U. S. casualties daily. One practical way to help defeat this evil and bring about the healing and peace that only Jesus can give, is to participate in the VIGIL FOR LIFE: September 28 – November 6. 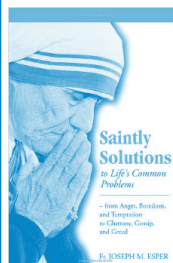

SEPTEMBER IS PAD AND ATRIAL FIBRILLATION AWARENESS MONTH

Atrial fibrillation is the most common type of irregular heartbeat and is a leading risk factor for stroke. Peripheral Arterial Disease (PAD) is a vascular condition related to heart disease and stroke.

What do they both have in common? They are both detectable with simple, painless screening.

This is why St Joachim's Catholic Church is hosting Life Line Screening, the nation's leading provider of preventive health screenings on **Monday, September 26, 2016**. The screenings provided focus on vascular disease, including atrial fibrillation and peripheral arterial disease.

Screenings are fast, painless and affordable. Three key tests check for blocked carotid arteries, atrial fibrillation, and high blood pressure, which are the three leading risk factors for stroke. Nearly 800,000 strokes will occur this year.

Other tests check for abdominal aortic aneurysms and PAD, also called "hardening of the arteries" in the legs. A bone density screening to assess osteoporosis risk is also offered and is appropriate for both men and women. Many events also offer blood tests, including cholesterol, glucose and c-reactive protein screenings, as well as take-home colon cancer early detection tests.

Screening packages start at \$139. Single tests cost around \$70.

El padre de ese niño, sea quien sea, también debe dar hasta que duela.

Con un aborto, la madre no aprende a amar, pero mata incluso a su propio hijo para resolver sus problemas.

Y, por el aborto, el padre se dice que no debe tomar ninguna responsabilidad en absoluto para el niño que ha traído al mundo. El padre es probable que ponga a otras mujeres en el mismo problema. Así que el aborto sólo conduce a más abortos.

Cualquier país que acepta el aborto no está enseñando a su gente a amar, pero usar cualquier violencia para obtener lo que quieren. Por esta razón el mayor destructor del amor y la paz es el aborto."
