PASTOR'S CORNER

Fight to Protect the Family! Cardinal Robert Sarah, the prefect for the Congregation of Divine Worship and the Sacraments, was the keynote speaker at the annual National Catholic Prayer Breakfast in Washington, D.C. on May 17, 2016. Here are a few excerpts from his address. "The battle to preserve the roots of mankind is perhaps the greatest challenge our world has faced since its origins. ... This is why it is so important to fight to protect the family, the first cell of the life of the Church and every society. ... This is about defending ourselves, children, and future generations from a demonic ideology that says children do not need mothers and fathers. ... Good becomes evil, beauty is ugly, love becomes the satisfaction of sexual primal instincts, and truths are all relative. ... All manner of immorality is not only accepted and tolerated today in advanced societies, but even promoted as a social good. The result is hostility to Christians, and, increasingly, religious persecution. Nowhere is [this] clearer than in the threat that societies are visiting on the family through a demonic 'gender ideology.' Do we not see signs of this insidious war in this great nation of the United States? ... In the name of 'tolerance,' the Church's teachings on marriage, sexuality, and the human person are dismantled. The legalization of same-sex marriage, the obligation to accept contraception within healthcare programs, and even 'bathroom bills' that allow men to use the women's restroom and locker rooms are being imposed on society." In conclusion, Sarah offered the faithful three suggestions: "Be prophetic, be faithful, and pray. For in the end it is 'God or nothing.'"

In this election season, let us remember: how I vote and who I vote for, is a powerful weapon for good or for ill, in the **Fight to Protect the Family**.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

¡Lucha Para Proteger a la Familia! El Cardenal Robert Sarah, el prefecto de la Congregación para el Culto Divino y los Sacramentos, fue el orador principal en el Desayuno Anual de Oración Nacional Católica de Washington, DC, el 17 de Mayo del 2016. He aquí algunos extractos de su discurso. "La batalla para preservar las raíces de la humanidad es tal vez el mayor desafío de nuestro mundo que ha enfrentado desde sus orígenes. ... Por eso es tan importante luchar para proteger a la familia, la primera pila de la vida de la Iglesia y toda la sociedad. ... Se trata de la defensa de nosotros mismos, los niños y las futuras generaciones de una ideología demoníaca que dice que los niños no necesitan de madres y padres. ... Lo bueno se convierte en malo, la belleza es feo, el amor se convierte en la satisfacción de los instintos primarios sexuales, y las verdades son todas relativas. ... Toda clase de inmoralidad no sólo es aceptada y tolerada hoy en las sociedades avanzadas, pero es promovido como un bien social. El resultado es la hostilidad hacia los Cristianos, y, cada vez más, la persecución religiosa. En ninguna parte esto [esta] más claro que en la amenaza de que las sociedades están visitando a la familia a través de una "ideología de género". ¿Es que no vemos los signos de esta guerra insidiosa en esta gran nación de los Estados Unidos? ... En el nombre de "tolerancia", las enseñanzas de la Iglesia sobre el matrimonio, la sexualidad, y la persona humana se desmantelan. La legalización del matrimonio entre personas del mismo sexo, la obligación de aceptar la anticoncepción dentro de los programas de salud, e incluso 'facturas de baño' que permiten a los hombres usar los baños y vestuarios de mujeres, se están imponiendo en la sociedad." En conclusión, Sarah ofreció a los fieles tres sugerencias: "Ser profético, ser fiel, y orar. Porque al final es 'Dios o nada'". En esta temporada electoral, recordemos: Cómo voto y por quien voto, es un arma poderosa para el bien y mal en la **Lucha Para Proteger a la Familia**.
