PASTOR'S CORNER

What is a "Pope Francis Catholic?" In these weeks leading toward an important election in November, it is important to dispel confusion associated with current political rhetoric. The impression is out there that a Catholic politician who is "personally pro-life, but has 'compassion' for women with unwanted pregnancies, and is completely in favor of protecting, and even promoting, a woman's right to choose abortion through legislation, executive action and judicial appointments, is a "Pope Francis Catholic." The Catholic Church is unambiguous in its condemnation of procured abortion as an intrinsic evil that can never be in conformity with the common good. The "compassion" that legally permits and even pressures women to destroy their unborn children is a false compassion and not worthy of the name. Because Pope Francis is so definitively compassionate in word and in deed toward those who are most in need, his name is being wrongly associated with the false compassion of the "pro-choice" ideology for abortion, euthanasia, same-sex attraction, and personal gender options, under the banner of "Who am I to judge?" In the interest of keeping love and truth together, here is a recent statement of Pope Francis from his Apostolic Exhortation on Love in the Family: "Here I feel it is urgent to state that, if the family is the sanctuary of life, the place where life is conceived and cared for, it is a horrendous contradiction when it becomes a place where life is rejected and destroyed. So great is the value of a human life, and so inalienable the right to life of an innocent child growing in the mother's womb, that no alleged right to one's own body can justify a decision to terminate that life, which is an end in itself and can never be considered the "property" of another human being" (Amoris Laetitia – 83).


For anyone who has been hurt by the evil of abortion, have hope. Jesus forgives and heals.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

¿Qué es un “Católico Papa Francisco?” En estas semanas previas a una elección importante en Noviembre, es importante aclarar la confusión asociada con la retórica política actual. La impresión por ahí es que un político católico que es personalmente pro-vida, pero tiene “compasión” para las mujeres con embarazos no deseados, y es completamente a favor de proteger e incluso promover, el derecho de la mujer a elegir el aborto a través de la legislación, la acción ejecutiva y los nombramientos judiciales, es un “Católico Papa Francisco.” La Iglesia Católica no tiene ambigüedades en su condena del aborto provocado como un mal intrínseco que nunca puede estar en conformidad con el bien común. La “compasión” que permite legalmente e incluso presiona a las mujeres a destruir sus hijos por nacer es una falsa compasión y no digna de ese nombre. Debido a que el Papa Francisco es definitivamente compasivo de palabra y de obra hacia los que más lo necesitan, su nombre se está usando erróneamente con la falsa compasión de la ideología “pro-elección” para el aborto, la eutanasia, la atracción del mismo sexo y opciones personales de género, bajo la bandera de “¿Quién soy yo para juzgar?” En el interés de mantener el amor y la verdad juntos, aquí hay una declaración reciente del Papa Francisco de su Exhortación Apostólica sobre el Amor en la Familia: “En este contexto, no puedo dejar de decir que, si la familia es el santuario de la vida, el lugar donde la vida es engendrada y cuidada, constituye una contradicción lacerante que se convierte en el lugar donde la vida es negada y destrozada. Es tan grande el valor de una vida humana, y es tan inalienable el derecho a la vida del niño inocente que se crece en el seno de su madre, que de ningún modo se puede plantear, como un derecho sobre el propio cuerpo, la posibilidad de tomar decisiones con respecto a esa vida, que es en fin en sí misma y que nunca puede ser un objeto de dominio de otro ser humano.” (Amoris Laetitia – 83)
 Para cualquier persona que ha sido lastimada por el mal del aborto, hay esperanza. Jesus perdona y sana.
