PASTOR'S CORNER

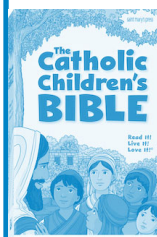
Why we need a NEW PENTECOST and a NEW EVANGELIZATION. As we mark the 99th Anniversary of the first apparition of Mary to the children in Fatima (May 13, 1917), we recall that part of the message of Fatima was that in the last days the devil's primary strategy will be to destroy marriage and the family. Since by God's design the family is "the domestic church," we understand that this strategy is his most effective way to weaken the Church. Though we can be confident that the "powers of death will not prevail" (Mt. 16: 18), we need to be wise enough to defend against the devil's tactics and to bring the victory of Jesus more to bear in a New Pentecost and a New Evangelization, beginning in our homes, our marriages and our families. In a recent interview, Pope Francis responded to a reporter in these words, "One of the recent popes, speaking of the Council, said that there were two councils: the Second Vatican Council in the Basilica of St. Peter, and the other, the council of the media. When I convoked the first Synod (on the Family), the great concern of the majority of the media was communion for the divorced and remarried, and, since I am not a saint, this bothered me, and then made me sad. Because, thinking of those media who said, this, this and that, do you not realize that that is not the important problem? Don't you realize that instead the family throughout the world is in crisis? Don't we realize that the falling birthrate in Europe is enough to make one cry? And the family is the basis of society. Do you not realize that the youth don't want to marry? ... Don't you realize that the lack of work, or the little work available, means that a mother has to get two jobs and the children grow up alone? These are the big problems." **Let us pray: O God, send forth your Creative Spirit and renew the face of the earth!**

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

Porque necesitamos un NUEVO PENTECOSTÉS y una NUEVA EVANGELIZACIÓN. Al conmemorar el 99 Aniversario de la primera aparición de María a los niños en Fátima (13 de Mayo, 1917), recordamos que parte del mensaje de Fátima fue que en los últimos días la estrategia primaria del diablo será destruir el matrimonio y la familia. Dado que por designio de Dios la familia es la "Iglesia doméstica", entendemos que esta estrategia es la forma más eficaz para debilitar a la Iglesia. Aunque podemos estar seguros de que "el poder de la muerte no podrá con ella." (Mt 16:18), tenemos que ser lo suficientemente inteligente para defendernos de las tácticas del diablo y traer la victoria de Jesús a un nuevo Pentecostés y una Nueva Evangelización, empezando en nuestros hogares, nuestros matrimonios y en nuestras familias. En una entrevista reciente, el Papa Francisco le respondió a un reportero en estas palabras; "Escuche, uno de los últimos Papas, hablando sobre el Concilio, dijo que había habido dos concilios: el Vaticano II, en la Basílica de San Pedro, y el otro, el "concilio de los medios de comunicación". Cuando convoqué el primer Sínodo, la gran preocupación de la mayor parte de los medios de comunicación era: ¿podrían recibir la comunión los divorciados que se han vuelto a casar? Y como yo no soy santo, eso me molestó un poco y también me dió un poco de tristeza. Porque yo pienso: pero esos medios de comunicación, que dicen tantas cosas, ¿no se dan cuenta de que no es ese el problema principal? ¿Acaso no se dan cuenta que la familia, en todo el mundo, está en crisis? Y la familia es la base de la sociedad. ¿No se percatan de que los jóvenes no quieren casarse? ¿No ven que la disminución de la natalidad en Europa es como para ponerse a llorar? ¿No saben que la falta de trabajo y la dificultad para encontrarlo obligan a que el padre y la madre tengan dos empleos, y que los niños crezcan solos, sin aprender a crecer en diálogo con papá y mamá? Estos son los grandes problemas." **Oremos: Envía, Señor, tu Espíritu. Que renueve la faz de la Tierra.**
