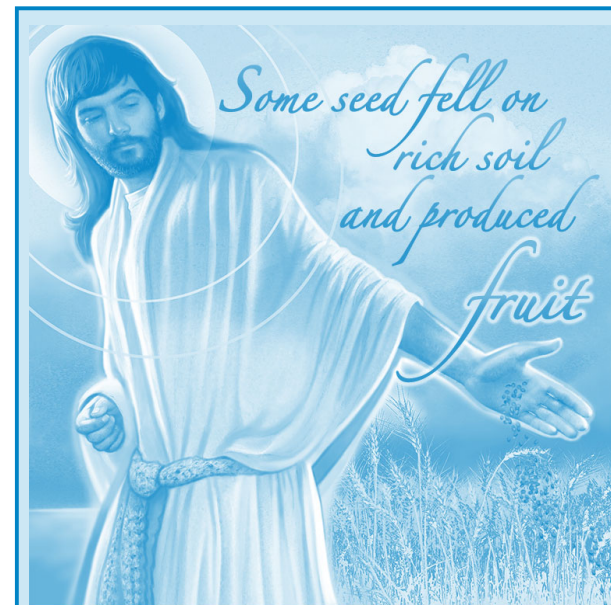

PASTOR'S CORNER

NINE MAXIMS (Part I): Some ideas are so good that they can motivate and move one toward WELL-BEING AND WELL-DOING. These are the kinds of ideas that are worth framing and putting on a wall so that they can be noticed and influence one often. They are of a proverbial nature. As I look around my office I can see nine maxims; some just a few words and others of paragraph length. In this Pastor's Corner, and in ones to come, I hope to get these maxims out of my office and into the minds and hearts of my parishioners, and maybe even on your walls. So here goes. **FIRST MAXIM:**

*As you ramble on through Life,
With Heaven as your Goal,
Keep your Eye upon the Doughnut,
And not upon the Hole.*

I begin with some definitions: "Doughnut" should be thought of as the really real, the eternal, the ultimate and absolute in Beauty, Love, Truth, Goodness and Shalom, GOD – Jesus, Father, Holy Spirit! "Hole" refers to whatever seems to be missing in my bodily, mental and/or spiritual health, and in my relationships. "Keep your Eye on" is best understood to mean, FOCUS. Focus ought to be intentional. It should be a virtuous personal decision; an act of my free will. Commentary: In this world, wounded by sin, my default focus tends to be on the hole; on any pain, sickness, sin, tiredness, frustration, fear, anger, or anxiety that I may be going through. With a focus on the hole, I lose perspective on the totality of reality and become depressed and discouraged. The wisdom of this maxim calls me to deliberately re-focus on the doughnut, especially as I start my day in a period of sufficient, quiet, personal, heart to Heart conversational prayer time. If I spend five to ten minutes focusing on the blessings of the last 24 hours, and of creation, my life, family, friends, vocation and redemption in Jesus, then I will have the perspective of knowing that I am infinitely loved by a Trinitarian God who has unspeakable affection for me. Then I can deal with the hole with confidence in Jesus' power to "work everything to the good for those who love him" (Romans 8:28). Bottom line, let us keep our eyes fixed on Jesus, "the Way, the Truth and the Life." (John 14:6). Jesus is the Doughnut. The devil is the hole.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

NUEVE MAXIMAS (Primera Parte): Algunas ideas son tan buenas que nos pueden motivar y mover para estar en BIENESTAR Y HACER EL BIEN. Estas son las clases de ideas que valen la pena enmarcar y poner en una pared de modo que puedan ser notados y que a menudo nos puedan influenciar. Son de carácter proverbial. Cuando miro alrededor de mi oficina veo nueve máximas; algunas de unas pocas palabras y otras de lo largo de un párrafo. En este Rincón del Párroco, y en los que vendrán, espero sacar estas máximas de mi oficina y en las mentes y corazones de mis feligreses, y tal vez incluso en sus paredes. Así es que aquí va la **PRIMERA MÁXIMA:**

*A medida que recorremos la Vida,
Con el Cielo como tu Meta,
Mantén tus Ojos sobre la Rosquilla,
Y no sobre el Agujero.*

Comienzo con algunas definiciones: La “Rosquilla” debe ser considerada realmente como lo eterno, lo último y lo absoluto en Belleza real, el Amor, la Verdad, la Bondad y la Paz, DIOS - ¡Jesús, Padre, Espíritu Santo! “Agujero” se refiere a lo que parece faltar en mi salud corporal, mental y/o espiritual, y en mis relaciones. “Mantén tus Ojos sobre la” se entiende mejor cuando significa, ENFOCAR. El enfoque debe ser intencional. Debe ser una decisión personal virtuosa; Un acto de mi libre albedrío. Comentario: En este mundo, herido por el pecado, mi enfoque predeterminado tiende a estar en el agujero; Sobre cualquier dolor, enfermedad, pecado, cansancio, frustración, miedo, ira o ansiedad que pueda estar pasando. El enfoque en el agujero, pierdo perspectiva sobre la totalidad de la realidad y me deprimó y me desanimó. La sabiduría de esta máxima me llama a volver a centrarme deliberadamente en la rosquilla, especialmente cuando comienzo mi día con un período de tiempo de oración de conversación suficiente, silenciosa, personal, de corazón a corazón. Si paso cinco o diez minutos enfocándome en las bendiciones de las últimas 24 horas, y en la creación, mi vida, familia, amigos, vocación y redención en Jesús, entonces tendré la perspectiva de saber que soy infinitamente amado por un Dios Trinitario que tiene afecto indescriptible por mí. Entonces puedo lidiar con el agujero con confianza en el poder de Jesús para “trabajar todo para el bien de los que lo aman” (Romanos 8:28). En pocas palabras, mantengamos los ojos fijos en Jesús, “el Camino, la Verdad y la Vida” (Juan 14:6). Jesús es la Rosquilla. El diablo es el agujero.
