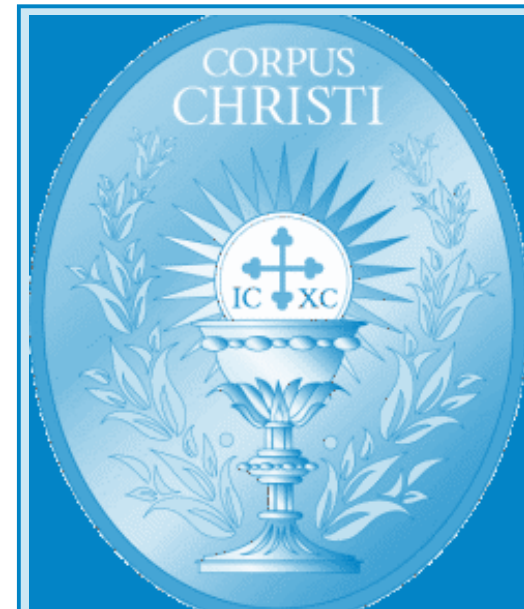

PASTOR'S CORNER

Pray and Live a Pentecost that is New, Personal and Perpetual! That's what all the Saints did. That is what Mary, the Queen of all Saints and the Mother of every Disciple modelled for us. Furthermore, she intercedes for our docility to the Holy Spirit in every present moment so that we can say with her, "I am the servant of the Lord; let it be done to me according to your Word." I recommend using the following **PRAYER OF SURRENDER** as a diving board into your daily, quiet, sufficient, personal, heart-to-heart prayer time with the Father and Jesus, in the grace and power of the Holy Spirit.

O Abba, our dearly beloved Father, You are the potter. We are the clay. I surrender myself to You. Do with me what You will. Whatever You do, I thank You for it. I am ready for everything and I accept everything, provided Your will be done in me and in all Your creatures. I desire nothing more, O my God. *(adapted from a prayer by Blessed Charles de Foucauld)*

O Jesus, our beloved crucified and risen Savior, Lord, Redeemer, Friend, shepherd and Bridegroom. You love your Love into me. You love your Life into me. You love your Life and Love into me. Thank You. I am crucified with you, yet I live, no longer I, but You live in me. I still live my human life, but it is a life of faith, hope and love, in You, the Son of God, Who love me and lay down Your Life for me. Live Your Life through me! *(adapted from Galatians 2:19-20)*

O loving Spirit of the Father and Jesus, fall afresh on me. Melt me, mold me, fill me, use me! In You I live and move and have my being. Apart from You I can do nothing. Live Your Life through me! *(adapted from a lyric by Daniel Iverson and from Acts 17:28 and John 15:5)*

I entrust my soul, my self, my being into Your hands, I give it to you my God; with all the love of my heart, with unshakable confidence in Your Faithfulness, with hope in Your Promises, because I love you, I trust You, I hope in You, O Abba, our dearly beloved Father, O Jesus, our beloved crucified and risen Savior, O loving Spirit of the Father and Jesus. Live your Life through me! *(Adapted from a prayer by Blessed Charles de Foucauld)*


