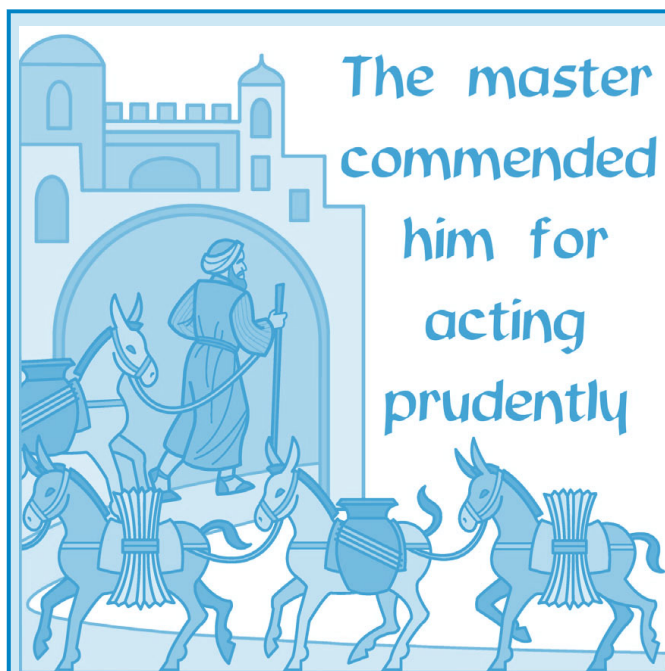

PASTOR'S CORNER

A WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT (Part One). Saint Peter tells us, *"There is cause for rejoicing here. You may for a time have to suffer the distress of many trials. But this is so that your faith, which is more precious than the passing splendor of fire-ried gold, may by its genuineness, lead to praise, glory and honor when Jesus Christ appears"* (1 Peter 1:6-7). But if I am going through the distress of sickness, injury, inability to pay my bills, marriage problems, broken family relationships, persecution, death of a loved one, fear, anxiety, hurt feelings, loneliness, etc., just **how can I get in touch with the cause for rejoicing?** Pope Francis put it this way, "Joy adapts and changes, but it always endures, even as a flicker of light born of our personal certainty that, when everything is said and done, we are infinitely loved" (Joy of the Gospel 6). **Where does this "personal certainty that we are infinitely loved" come from?** The church calls this personal certainty **the gift of faith.** Saint Paul assures us, *"Therefore, since we are justified by faith, we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ. Through him we have obtained access to this grace in which we stand, and we rejoice in our hope of sharing the glory of God. More than that, we rejoice in our sufferings, knowing that suffering produces endurance, and endurance produces character, and character produces hope, and hope does not disappoint us, because God's love has been poured into our hearts through the Holy spirit which has been given to us"* (Romans 5:1-5). **And just how can I receive and nurture this gift of faith so that I can actually enter into this Gospel Joy, and not merely hear about it?** More next week.

PALABRAS DE ANIMO (Primera Parte) San Pedro nos dice; *"Por eso viven alegres, aunque un poco afligidos ahora es cierto, a causa de tantas pruebas. Pero así la autenticidad de su fe —más valiosa que el oro, el cual es perecedero a pesar de haber sido glorificado en el fuego— será motivo de alabanza, gloria y honor el día en que se manifieste Jesucristo."* (1 Pedro 1:6-7). Pero si estoy pasando por la angustia de una enfermedad, de una lesión, incapacidad para pagar mis cuentas, problemas en el matrimonio, las rotas relaciones en la familia, la persecución, la muerte de un ser querido, el miedo, la ansiedad, sentimientos heridos, la soledad, etc., **¿cómo puedo vivir el motivo de la alegría?** El Papa lo pone de esta manera, "Se adapta y se transforma, y siempre permanece al menos como un brote de luz que nace de la certeza personal de ser infinitamente amado, más allá de todo." (La Alegría del Evangelio 6) **¿De dónde viene esa "certeza personal que somos infinitamente amados"?** La iglesia llama esta certeza personal **el regalo de la fe.** San Pablo nos asegura, *"Así pues, quienes mediante la fe estamos recibiendo la salvación, vivimos en paz con Dios por medio de nuestro Señor Jesucristo. Por la fe en Cristo hemos llegado a obtener esta situación de gracia que vivimos y de la que sentimos orgullosos, esperando participar de la gloria de Dios. Y no solo esto, sino que hasta de los sufrimientos nos sentimos orgullosos, sabiendo que los sufrimientos producen paciencia; la paciencia produce virtud sólida, y la virtud solida, esperanza. Una esperanza que no defrauda porque, al darnos el Espíritu Santo, Dios ha derramado su amor en nuestros corazones."* (Romanos 5:1-5) **¿Y cómo puedo recibir y cuidar de este don de la fe para que realmente pueda entrar en este Evangelio de la alegría, y no sólo oír hablar de eso?** Mas la próxima semana.
