**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**“Truly, I say to you, whoever does not receive the Kingdom of God like a little child shall not enter it.” (Mk. 10:15).** What does it mean to be “child-like”? Certainly, it does not mean to be immature and childish. Then what does it mean? The answer to this question is critical, for, as Jesus solemnly assures us, without being child-like, none of us will enter his Kingdom. St. Therese of the Child Jesus was proclaimed a Doctor of the Church and a saint for our times precisely because she communicated better than any other what it means to be “child-like” in the way we relate to God. In my estimation, Fr. Michael Gaitley, MIC, has surpassed all other authors in his ability to clearly communicate the “Little Way” of St. Therese to our contemporary minds and hearts. I heartily recommend his book, 33 Days to Merciful love – A Do-It-Yourself Retreat in Preparation for Consecration to Divine Mercy. In it Fr. Gaitley combines the wisdom of St. Therese on being child-like with the wisdom of St. Faustina on Divine Mercy to give us a practical way to intensely live in the Kingdom of God right here, right now, on our pilgrim journey to Heaven. I totally agree with this review by Brian Kelly, “Father Gaitley’s popular preparation for Marian Consecration, 33 Days to Morning Glory, is a masterpiece that I didn’t think he could outdo. I was wrong. 33 Days to Merciful Love presents the rare case where the sequel surpasses the original.” Both masterpieces are available in the St. Marelo Bookstore. (While we await the translation into Spanish, one could benefit from reading St. Therese’s autobiography, The Story of a Soul in the Spanish translation.

#### Taxpayers Should Not Be Asked to Pay for Lethal Drugs



Governor Brown's proposed 2016 Budget recommends \$1.4 million to purchase lethal drugs for more than 200

Medi-Cal patients (400+ next year) for those who want their physician to help them commit suicide.

California would pay an estimated \$5,400 per patient just for the drugs yet MediCal participants are not currently offered a MediCal benefit for palliative care (designed to improve the quality of life for patients and their family facing serious illnesses.) It is our hope that the Governor and Legislature will improve the quality of life for Californians, not improve access to ending it. Please urge your Legislator and the Governor not to support this expansion of physician-assisted suicide.
