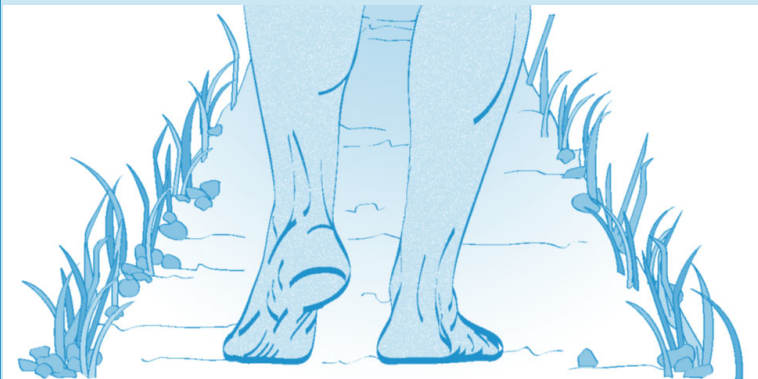

PASTOR'S CORNER

Only 92 days left in the Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy! Try to take advantage of the special blessings before time runs out.

WHAT IS A HOLY DOOR? A Holy door, such as the one approved by Bishop Ochoa for St. Joachim Church during the Extraordinary Jubilee Year of Mercy, symbolizes Christ, who called himself, "the gate" to eternal life (Jn. 10:9). For pilgrims, to walk through the Holy Door is to walk, in spirit, from sin to grace and from death to life, acknowledging Christ as the only way to the Father. During this Year of Mercy those who walk through the Holy Door will have the opportunity to obtain a plenary or a partial indulgence for themselves or for a departed loved one.

WHAT ARE INDULGENCES? They are an ongoing manifestation of God's mercy in the world, freeing us "from every residue left by the consequences of sin," and enabling us to "act with charity" and "grow in love" (*Misericordiae Vultus, No. 22*). As the Church understands it, through the centuries, by God's grace, holy men and women have done good works. They've prayed, suffered, sacrificed and served. Through this loving, fruitful exchange of grace and good works, something like an excess of merit and grace builds up. We call this excess "The Treasury of the Saints." It is, in a sense, like a bank account of graced merit, which the rest of us can draw upon to escape the temporal punishment for our sins. Or, as Pope Francis put it, "[the saints'] holiness comes to the aid of our weakness in a way that enables the Church, with her maternal prayers and her way of life, to fortify the weakness of some with the strength of others" (*Misericordiae Vultus, No. 22*). 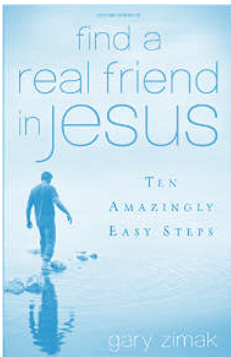

¿QUÉ ES UNA PUERTA SANTA? Una Puerta Santa, es como la que fue aprobada por el Obispo Ochoa para la Iglesia San Joaquín durante el Año Jubilar de la Misericordia y que simboliza a Cristo, que se hace llamar “la puerta” a la vida eterna. (Jn. 10:9) Para los peregrinos, que caminan a través de la Puerta Santa es caminar, en espíritu, del pecado a la gracia y de la muerte a la vida, reconociendo a Cristo como el único camino al Padre. Durante este Año de la Misericordia los que caminen por la Puerta Santa, tendrán la oportunidad de obtener una indulgencia plenaria o parcial para ellos mismos o para un ser querido que ya ha fallecido.

¿QUÉ SON LAS INDULGENCIAS? Son una manifestación permanente de la misericordia de Dios en el mundo, liberándonos de “las contradicciones que son consecuencias de nuestros pecados,” y que no nos permite “actuar con caridad” y “crecer en el amor” (Misericordiae Vultus, No.22). La Iglesia entiende que, a través de los siglos, por la gracia de Dios, los hombres, y las mujeres santas han hecho buenas obras. Han orado, sufrido, se han sacrificado, y servido. A través de este amoroso y fructífero intercambio de gracias y buenas obras, se acumula, algo así como un exceso de mérito y gracia. Llamamos a este exceso de “El Tesoro de los Santos.” Es, un cierto sentido, como una cuenta bancaria de los méritos de gracia, de la cual el resto de nosotros puede recurrir para escapar de la pena temporal por nuestros pecados. O como el Papa Francisco lo pone, “Su santidad [los santos] viene en ayuda de nuestra fragilidad, y así la Madre Iglesia es capaz con su oración y su vida de ir al encuentro de la debilidad de unos con la santidad de otros.” (Misericordiae Vultus, No. 22). (Mas por venir la próxima semana.)
