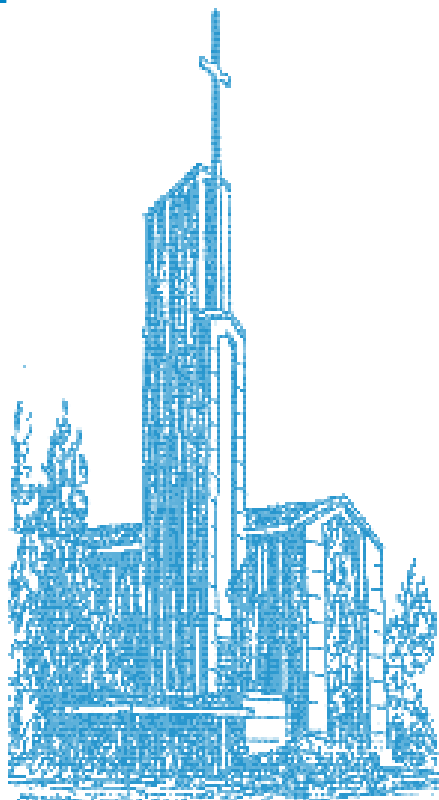

PASTOR'S CORNER

MARY, MOTHER OF GOD AND OUR MOTHER. We are in the month of May, a month specially dedicated to the Blessed Virgin Mary. On May 30th we will celebrate the feast day of St. Joseph Marelllo, a great Marian Josephite saint. He is the founder of the Oblates of St. Joseph who serve our parish. Here are some thoughts from one of St. Marelllo's homilies from 1884. ...

"The most holy Virgin is the Mother of God! A great and most high dignity! In his providence God wanted to give us Jesus through Mary: so God wants all graces to come through her hands; so everything we need should come from her. Most Holy Mary is also our Mother: what great confidence we should have in her! Let us think: if the mothers of the earth have a great love for their children, how much more love will the blessed Virgin have for us, she who loved her Jesus so much, and in spite of that, gave him up to death for us? So have the highest confidence in Mary and try to deserve her protection by paying her your filial homage. This should not consist just in the recitation of the Hail Mary and the holy Rosary, or in offering flowers or in some visits to her altars; but rather by imitating her example and doing what she desires. We should think of her everyday, every hour and always look at her example. She will be our teacher, adviser and guide in everything. If we consider her always as our mother, trying to imitate her faithfully, we will be also brothers and sisters of Jesus and co-heirs with him of heaven; and Mary, after protecting us here in this life, at the moment of death, will carry us in her arms and take us to our heavenly homeland."

La Santísima Virgen es también nuestra Madre: ¡qué gran confianza debemos tener en ella! Pensemos: si las madres de la tierra tienen un gran amor por sus hijos, ¿cuánto amor tendrá la bendita Virgen por nosotros, la que amó tanto a su Jesús y, a pesar de eso, lo entregó a la muerte por nosotros? Así que ten la más alta confianza en María y trata de merecer su protección pagándole tu homenaje filial. Esto no debe consistir sólo en la recitación del Ave María y el Santo Rosario, o en ofrecerle flores o en algunas visitas a sus altares; Sino más bien imitando su ejemplo y haciendo lo que ella desea. Debemos pensar en ella todos los días, cada hora y siempre mirar su ejemplo. Ella será maestra, consejera y guía en todo. Si la consideramos siempre como nuestra madre, tratando de imitarla fielmente, seremos también hermanos y hermanas de Jesús y coherederos con él del cielo; Y María, después de protegernos aquí en esta vida, en el momento de la muerte, nos llevará en sus brazos y nos llevará a nuestra patria celestial.”
