**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**January 22, 1973**, a date that will go down in infamy! This was the date in U.S. history on which seven Supreme Court "justices" decided to lift the protection of the law from human life in the womb. 1/22/73 was the date when it became "legal" in the U. S. for a mother to deliberately kill her own pre-born child through procured abortion. In the last 44 years, worldwide, more than 1.5 billion innocents have lost their lives through both, freely chosen, and coerced, abortions. This massive genocide ought to be recognized as the most horrid Satanic attack against God and human life in human history. **This is a call to action!** The worst thing we can do is to simply lament this evil with words, and then do nothing to stop it. Let us be encouraged by the words of Catholic convert, G. K. Chesterton, "*God himself will not help us to ignore evil, but only to defy and defeat it. But the finding and fighting of positive evil is the beginning of all fun.*" Saint Paul informs us, "*Our battle is not against flesh and blood ... but against evil spirits*" (*Ephesians 6:12*). We expose and reject the deceptive rhetoric that calls abortion a "reproductive right," and then accuses pro-lifers of waging a "war against women." We raise the banner of love for both the child and the woman. Indeed, we raise the banner of love and respect for the intrinsic dignity and inalienable right to life, liberty and justice for every human being, no exceptions. We take up our spiritual weapons of prayer and fasting, and especially the weapon of the daily rosary. We take up our political weapons; once again sending eight bus loads to the West Coast Walk for Life, with determination to support genuinely pro- life politicians when we exercise our duty to vote, or, even run for office. We re-dedicate our time, talent and treasure in support of Esperanza de Vida, our parish pro-life ministry, Rachel's Vineyard Healing Retreats, Doors of Hope and Central Valley Right to Life.
