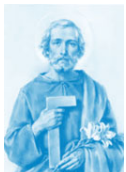

We celebrate THE MIRACLE OF MERCY on DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY. The Miracle of Mercy took place when the risen Jesus returned to the sinful world that crucified Him with the words, **“Peace be with you. ... Receive the Holy Spirit. ...Whose sins you forgive are forgiven them...” (Jn.20:21-23).** Find below more words of the Risen Jesus as written in the Diary of St. Faustina. **The greater the sinner, the greater the right he has to my mercy (Diary, 723).** [Let] the greatest sinners place their trust in My mercy. They have the right before others to trust in the abyss of My mercy. My daughter, write about My mercy towards tormented souls. Souls that make an appeal to My mercy delight Me. To such souls I grant even more graces than they ask. I cannot punish even the greatest sinner if he makes an appeal to My compassion, but on the contrary, I justify him in my unfathomable and inscrutable mercy. Write: before I come as a just Judge, I first open wide the door of My mercy. He who refuses to pass through the door of My mercy must pass through the door of My justice... (Diary, 1146).
