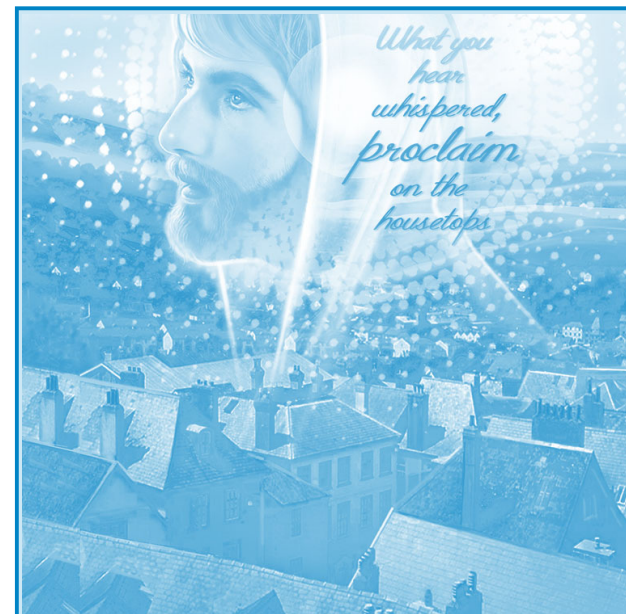

PASTOR'S CORNER

REST IN PEACE, FR. LUPE

Let us thank God for the gift of the life of Father Lupe Sanchez, OSJ, born on the Feast of Our Lady of Guadalupe, December 12, 1931. On September 9, 1956, he made his perpetual profession of religious vows in the Oblates of St. Joseph, an international Congregation of Brothers and Priests founded in Italy by St. Joseph Marrello. Fr. Lupe's spirituality was marked by the Marrellian charism of humility, love, faith, and hard work, serving the interests of Jesus in the way of St. Joseph. Fr. Lupe also strove to live the spirituality of the Focolare Movement, living an ordinary life with great love. Some will remember Fr. Lupe's prowess as an athlete. He was very skilled at tennis and a good swimmer. Here is an eye-witness account of one of his exploits. "Once when the whole seminary was at the beach near Lighthouse Point in Santa Cruz, 4 people were trapped by a rip tide and in danger of drowning, not being able to get back to shore. He swam against the tide and brought them in one by one to shore, with the slight help of another strong swimmer, whom he directed how to do it." Truly, Fr. Lupe was very generous in his efforts to serve the needs of others. He cared about the eternal salvation of all. He dedicated his life to the mission of saving souls. He spent hours making himself available in the Sacrament of Reconciliation beyond the scheduled times for Confession. He was a leader in meeting the spiritual needs of Spanish speaking immigrants. He worked hard collecting and distributing food to the materially poor through the St. Vincent de Paul Society, the Holy Family Table and countless home visits. Fr. Lupe was ordained a priest on June 10, 1960. During his 57 years as a priest, he served the people of God for some years in seminary formation houses in Santa Cruz and Berkeley, but mostly in parishes, a few years each in, Davenport, Planada, Easton, Caruthers and Bakersfield, but a total of 23 years in Madera. His final years were spent in prayer and charitable service at a rest home in Northern Italy. At the age of 85, he died peacefully on the Lord's Day, June 18, a day we fittingly celebrated as Fathers' Day and as the great Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ. Let us pray for the eternal repose of Fr. Lupe's soul, as we can be sure that Fr. Lupe will continue to pray for us.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

DESCANSE EN PAZ, PADRE LUPE

Damos gracias a Dios por el don de la vida del Padre Lupe Sánchez, OSJ, quien nació en la Fiesta de Nuestra Señora de Guadalupe, el 12 de diciembre del 1931. El 9 de Septiembre de 1956 hizo su profesión perpetua de votos religiosos con los Oblatos de San José, una Congregación Internacional de Hermanos y Sacerdotes fundada en Italia por San José Marelllo. La espiritualidad del Padre Lupe fué marcada por el carisma Marelliano de humildad, amor, fe y trabajo duro, sirviendo los intereses de Jesús como San José. Padre Lupe también se esforzó por vivir la espiritualidad del Movimiento de Focolare, viviendo una vida común con gran amor. Algunos recordarán la habilidad del Padre Lupe como atleta. Era muy hábil en el tenis y un buen nadador. He aquí un testimonio de una de sus hazañas. "Una vez, cuando todo el seminario estaba en la playa cerca de Lighthouse Point en Santa Cruz, 4 personas quedaron atrapadas por una marea y en peligro de ahogarse, no pudiendo regresar a la orilla. Nadó contra la marea y los llevó uno por uno a la orilla, con la ligera ayuda de otro nadador fuerte, a quien dirigió cómo hacerlo." Verdaderamente el Padre Lupe fué muy generoso en sus esfuerzos por servir las necesidades de los demás. Se preocupaba por la salvación eterna de todos. Dedicó su vida a la misión de salvar almas. Pasó horas haciéndose disponible en el Sacramento de la Reconciliación más allá de los tiempos programados para la Confesión. Él era un líder en la satisfacción de las necesidades espirituales de los inmigrantes de habla hispana. Trabajó duro recolectando y distribuyendo alimentos y materiales a los pobres a través de la Sociedad San Vicente, la Mesa de la Sagrada Familia e innumerables visitas a domicilios. El Padre Lupe fué ordenado sacerdote el 10 de Junio del 1960. Durante sus 57 años como sacerdote, sirvió al pueblo de Dios durante algunos años en casas de formación de seminarios en Santa Cruz y Berkeley, pero principalmente en parroquias, algunos años en Davenport, Planada, Easton, Caruthers y Bakersfield, pero un total de 23 años en Madera. Sus últimos años se los pasó en oración y servicio de caridad en una casa de descanso en el Norte de Italia. A la edad de 85 años, murió en paz en el Día del Señor, el 18 de Junio, día que celebramos el Día de los Padres y la gran Solemnidad del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo. Oremos por el eterno reposo del Padre Lupe, como podemos estar seguros de que el Padre Lupe continuará orando por nosotros.
