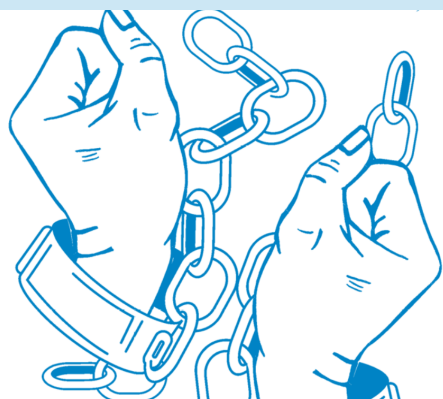

**PASTOR'S CORNER**

**A WORD OF ENCOURAGEMENT** (Part two). "There is cause for rejoicing here" (St. Peter). The gift of faith can give us "certainty that we are infinitely loved" (Pope Francis). So, in the midst of my sufferings, **how can I enter into the Joy of the Gospel and the certainty that I am infinitely loved?** Faith is a twofold reality: it is God's initiative, God's Gift of Self, the Holy Spirit, Divine Love, ready to be poured into my heart, (Romans 5:1-5) and it is my free response, my receiving the Gift. I may need to repent of sin and remove obstacles so that the Divine Gift, the Trinity, may abide in my heart. But, even in the process of repentance, humble confession, forgiveness of sin and healing the effects of sin, it is God's initiative, God's grace, and my free cooperation that readies me to receive God's Gift of Self on ever deeper levels. Jesus compares the initial gift of faith to a seed, a seed that needs good soil in order to grow and bear fruit. Thus, growing in faith – hope – love, in response to God loving me first, always and infinitely, becomes a life-long process of me saying "Yes" to the Gift day by day. The infallible sign that this is occurring is the fruit of Gospel Joy in my life. This Gospel Joy is rooted in God who is the Eternal Present Reality of transcendent Goodness, Justice, Beauty, Truth, and Merciful Love. This Joy transcends my ever-changing circumstances and is deeper than my fluctuating sorrows. Gospel Joy is not fragile and tentative. Gospel Joy is as hard as a diamond, so hard you can chip your tooth on it! Next week we will explore an essential and practical way to say, "Yes" to God's Self-Gift day by day. Stay tuned.

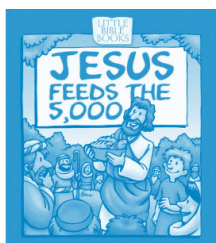

## RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

**PALABRAS DE ANIMO (Segunda Parte)** “Por eso viven alegres.” (San Pedro) El regalo de la fe nos da “la certeza personal de ser infinitamente amados.” Entonces, en medio de mis sufrimientos, **¿cómo puedo entrar en la alegría del Evangelio y en la certeza personal que soy infinitamente amado?** La fe es una doble realidad: es la iniciativa de Dios, el regalo de Dios de sí Mismo, el Espíritu Santo, el Amor Divino, listo para ser derramado en mi corazón, (Romanos 5:1-5) y es mi respuesta libre, al recibir el regalo. Puede que tenga que arrepentirse del pecado y eliminar los obstáculos para que el don divino, la Trinidad, pueda permanecer en mi corazón. Pero, incluso en el proceso de arrepentimiento, una confesión humilde, el perdón del pecado y la curación de los efectos del pecado, es la iniciativa de Dios, la gracia de Dios, y mi cooperación libre en prepararme para recibir el regalo de Dios de uno mismo en niveles cada vez más profundos. Jesús compara el don de una fe inicial a una semilla, una semilla que necesita buena tierra con el fin de crecer y dar frutos. Por lo tanto, crecer en la fe - esperanza - amor, en respuesta a Dios amarme primero, siempre e infinitamente, se convierte en un proceso de toda la vida de mí diciendo "Sí" al regalo del día a día. El signo infalible de que esto está ocurriendo es el fruto del Evangelio de la alegría en mi vida. Este Evangelio de la alegría tiene sus raíces en Dios, que es la realidad actual de la Bondad Eterna trascendente, Justicia, Belleza, Verdad y Amor Misericordioso. Esta alegría trasciende mis circunstancias siempre cambiantes y es más profundo que mis dolores fluctuantes. La alegría del Evangelio no es frágil y provisional. La alegría del Evangelio es tan dura como el diamante, ¡tan fuerte que puedes astillar su diente en él! La próxima semana vamos a explorar una forma esencial y práctica para decir, "Sí" a día de auto-regalo de Dios al día. Manténganse al tanto.
