TRIBUNAL OF MERCY (an excerpt from *Mercy's Gaze*, 100 Readings from Scripture and the Diary of St. Faustina, by Vinny Flynn – available in the St. Marello Bookstore).

“Tell souls where they are to look for solace; that is, in the Tribunal of Mercy [The Sacrament of Reconciliation]. There the greatest miracles take place. ... It suffices to come with faith to the feet of my representative and to reveal to him one's misery, and the miracle of Divine Mercy will be fully demonstrated. Were a soul like a decaying corpse so that from a human standpoint, there would be no [hope of] restoration and everything would already be lost, it is not so with God. The miracle of Divine Mercy restores that soul in full.” – Diary, 1448

It stands for **Our Faith, Our Family, Our Future.** It is a capital funds campaign to help the parishes and ministries in the Diocese of Fresno. It was begun in 2004 and we had an initial goal of \$680,400.00. We were excused from making contributions in the initial years since we were having our fundraising campaign to build the new school, parish center, and St. Marelo bookstore. We did not begin making contributions until November 2010 after we finished paying off the Diocesan Building Loan. Below are the annual amounts paid and running balances through June 2016.

MOTHER OF PERPETUAL HELP

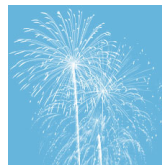
