PASTOR'S CORNER

HOW DOES ONE OBTAIN AN INDULGENCE? The primary condition is a complete detachment from sin, including venial sin. Indulgences are in no way automatic: mechanically repeating certain practices in order to acquire them is not enough. If the fundamental condition of sincere repentance and a complete detachment from sin is not met, then the indulgence will not be plenary but partial. A person wishing to obtain an indulgence must 1) go to confession, 2) receive Holy Communion, 3) pray according to the Pope's intentions and 4) fulfill the act that is attached to the indulgence. What are some of these acts? Here is a very partial list: A. Walk through one of the official Holy Doors during a Jubilee year, B. Prayerfully read Sacred Scripture for at least 30 minutes, C. Pray five decades of the Rosary **in a family or an association of the faithful**, D. Pray before the Blessed Sacrament for at least 30 minutes, And many more. In every case, however, the conditions for obtaining an indulgence remain the same: complete detachment from sin, reception of the Eucharist, making a good confession that day or on a proximate day, praying for the intentions of the Pope and being in a state of grace by the time the work for the indulgence is complete. **A single sacramental confession suffices for gaining several plenary indulgences; but Holy Communion must be received and prayer for the intention of the Holy Father must be recited for the gaining of each plenary indulgence.**

Try not to neglect this powerful work of Mercy, for your own benefit, and for the benefit of others. Let the Jubilee Year of Mercy help you to make this work of Mercy a regular part of your spiritual life.

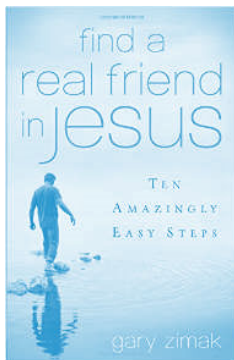

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

¿CÓMO SE OBTIENE UNA INDULGENCIA?

La condición principal es un completo desapego del pecado, incluyendo el pecado venial. Las indulgencias no son un modo automático: no es suficiente, repetir mecánicamente ciertas prácticas con el fin de adquirirlas. Si no se cumple la condición fundamental del arrepentimiento sincero y un total desapego del pecado, entonces la indulgencia plenaria no será sino parcial. Una persona que desee obtener una indulgencia debe 1) Ir a confesión 2) Recibir la Sagrada Comunión, 3) Orar de acuerdo a las intenciones del Papa y 4) Cumplir con el acto que se adjunta la indulgencia. ¿Cuáles son algunos de esos actos? Aquí esta una lista muy parcial: A. Caminar a través de una de la Puertas Santas oficiales durante este Año Jubilar, B. Leer las Sagradas Escrituras y orar por menos de 30 minutos, C. Rezar cinco décadas del Rosario **en familia o con la asociación de fe**, D. Rezar ante el Santísimo Sacramento por lo menos 30 minutos, y mucho más. Sin embargo, en todos los casos, las condiciones para obtener una indulgencia siguen siendo las mismas: un desapego total del pecado, la recepción de la Eucaristía, hacer una buena confesión ese día o dentro de los 8 días, el momento que la indulgencia es completada. **Basta con una sola confesión sacramental para ganar varias indulgencias plenarias; pero se debe recibir la Sagrada Comunión y rezar la oración del Padre Nuestro para obtener la indulgencia plenaria.**

Trate de no descuidar esta poderosa oportunidad de Misericordia, para su propio beneficio y para el beneficio de los demás. Deje que el Año Jubilar de la Misericordia le ayude a hacer esta oportunidad de la Misericordia una parte regular de su vida espiritual.
