PASTOR'S CORNER

On Tuesday, May 30th, we celebrate the Feast of St. Joseph Marello, a holy bishop and the founder of the Oblates of St. Joseph in 1878. His intercession for us in heaven and his charism of serving the interests of Jesus through the virtues of St. Joseph, continue to be a blessing for our parish and for the Church throughout the world. Here are two excerpts from St. Marello's 6th Pastoral Letter written in 1894. His words are as relevant today as they were 123 years ago.

For the moral perfection of man, it does not suffice to have a culture of the mind without an education of the heart; or to say it better: instruction without the accompaniment of religion cannot give true light to the intellect and move the will effectively to good; because to progress morally, man must know the end by which he moves, the end to which he tends, the model that must serve as norm, and the strength that must give him the necessary and timely help. Now, only the Catechism, in revealing to us the mystery of original sin, can make us know that man is born weak and corrupt, and therefore the first law of moral progress is not to support the instincts of corrupt nature, but to impede them; not to condescend to every inclination, but to dominate, mortify and deny oneself. ... J.J. Rousseau, who wrote so much to promote an instruction devoid of all religious principles and whose books were sadly so influential in perverting the morals of a people close to us, was so frightened by the deadly consequences of his irreligious doctrine that he wrote, "I cannot understand that any man can be virtuous without religion. It is true, I too held this false idea, but now I am entirely undeceived."

We commend the great team of parents, catechists, school personnel, youth ministers, adult evangelizers, deacons and priests in our parish who are working hard to educate both mind and heart of all the learners in our parish, young and old.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

El Martes, 30 de Mayo, celebramos la Fiesta de San José Marello, un Santo Obispo y fundador de los Oblatos de San José en 1878. Su intercesión por nosotros en el cielo y su carisma de servir a los intereses de Jesus a través de las virtudes de San José, continúan siendo una bendición para nuestra parroquia y para la Iglesia en todo el mundo. Aquí hay dos extractos de la Sexta Carta Pastoral escrita en 1894. Sus palabras son tan relevantes hoy como lo fueron hace 123 años.

Para la perfección moral del hombre, no basta tener una cultura de la mente sin una educación del corazón; para decirlo mejor: la instrucción sin el acompañamiento de la religión no puede dar luz verdadera al intelecto y mover la voluntad efectivamente para el bien; porque para progresar moralmente, el hombre debe conocer el fin por el cual se mueve, el fin al que el tiende como el modelo que debe servir de norma y la fuerza que debe darle la ayuda necesaria y oportuna. Ahora bien, sólo el Catecismo, nos revela el misterio del pecado original, puede hacernos saber que el hombre nace débil y corrupto, y por lo tanto la primera ley del progreso moral no es apoyar los instintos de la naturaleza corrupta sino impedirlo; no condescender a toda inclinación, sino dominar, mortificar y negarse a sí mismo. ...J.J. Rousseau, quien escribió tanto para promover una instrucción desprovista de todos los principios religiosos y cuyos libros son tan tristemente influyentes para pervertir la moral de un pueblo cercano, estaba tan asustado por las mortales consecuencias de su doctrina irreligiosa que escribió: "No puedo entender que cualquier hombre pueda ser virtuoso sin religión. Es verdad, yo también tuve esa idea falsa, pero ahora estoy completamente desengañando."

Felicitemos al gran equipo de padres, catequistas, personal de la escuela, los ministros de los jóvenes, los evangelizadores de adultos, los diáconos y los sacerdotes de nuestra parroquia que están trabajando arduamente para educar la mente y el corazón de todos los estudiantes en nuestra parroquia, tanto jóvenes como adultos.
