PASTOR'S CORNER

Did you know that your body has a theology? Why, yes it does! *"The body, in fact, and it alone, is capable of making visible what is invisible: the spiritual and the divine. It was created in order to transfer into the visible reality of the world, the mystery hidden since time immemorial in God, and thus to be a sign of it."* (St. John Paul II). This weekend our Parish Youth Ministry is presenting another "Theology of the Body Retreat" for our young people. Let us pray for the retreat team and the youth who are contemplating this Gospel of Life, this Gospel of the God-given meaning human sexuality, and this Gospel of marriage and family in Trinitarian Love. But this Theology of the Body is not just for young people; it is essential for all of us if we are to live fully the abundant life God is offering us through Jesus and his Bride, the Church. *"The nuptial meaning of the body is the fundamental element of human existence in the world."... "Every man and every woman fully realizes himself or herself through the sincere gift of self. For spouses, the moment of conjugal union constitutes a very particular expression of this. It is then that a man and a woman become a mutual gift to each other"* (St. John Paul II; Letter to Families 12). Though conjugal union is *"a very particular expression of the sincere gift of self,"* it is not the only expression. Reverence for the God-given meaning of human sexuality and marriage recognizes that chaste abstinence from deliberate sexual arousal before marriage is also an expression of true love and the sincere gift of self. Freely chosen mutual abstinence from the conjugal act within marriage for a responsible reason is also an expression of true love and the sincere gift of self. We note that the Church considers the unique and virginal marriage of the Holy Spouses, Mary and Joseph, to be a valid marriage and a true model of mutual, sincere gift of self, to married couples, to those preparing for marriage, and to those called to consecrated celibacy for the sake of the Kingdom. For further reading on the Theology of the Body I recommend Christopher West's book, Good News about Sex and Marriage, available at the St. Marelllo Bookstore.

RINCÓN DEL PÁRROCO

¿Sabías que tu cuerpo tiene una teología? ¡Sí, sí lo tiene! *“El cuerpo, de hecho, y sólo él, es capaz de hacer visible lo que es invisible: lo espiritual y lo divino. Fue creado para trasladar a la realidad visible del mundo, el misterio escondido desde tiempos inmemoriales en Dios, y así ser un signo de ello.”* (San Juan Pablo II). Este fin de semana nuestro Ministerio Pastoral Juvenil presentará otro “Retiro de Teología del Cuerpo” para nuestros jóvenes. Oremos por el equipo de retiro y los jóvenes que están contemplando este Evangelio de Vida, este Evangelio del significado dado por Dios de la sexualidad humana, y este Evangelio del matrimonio y de la familia en el Amor Trinitario. Pero esta Teología del Cuerpo no es sólo para los jóvenes; es esencial para todos nosotros si queremos vivir plenamente la vida abundante que Dios nos está ofreciendo a través de Jesús y su Esposa, la Iglesia. *“El significado nupcial del cuerpo es el elemento fundamental de la existencia humana en el mundo” ... “Cada hombre y cada mujer se realiza plenamente a través del don sincero de sí mismo. Para los cónyuges, el momento de la unión conyugal constituye una expresión muy particular de esto. Es entonces cuando un hombre y una mujer se convierten mutuamente en un don mutuo.”* (San Juan Pablo II, Carta a las Familias 12). Aunque la unión conyugal es *“una expresión muy particular del don sincero del yo”*, no es la única expresión. La reverencia por el significado dado por Dios de la sexualidad humana y el matrimonio reconoce que la abstinencia y la castidad de la excitación sexual deliberada antes del matrimonio es también una expresión del verdadero amor y el don sincero de sí mismo. La abstinencia mutua libremente elegida del acto conyugal dentro del matrimonio por una razón responsable es también una expresión del amor verdadero y del don sincero de sí mismo. Observamos que la Iglesia considera el matrimonio único y virginal de los Santos Esposos, María y José, un matrimonio válido y un verdadero modelo del mutuo y sincero don de sí, a los matrimonios, a los que se preparan para el matrimonio y a los llamados al celibato consagrado por el bien del Reino. Para leer más sobre la Teología del Cuerpo, recomiendo el libro de Christopher West, Good News about Sex and Marriage, disponible en la librería San Marelló.
